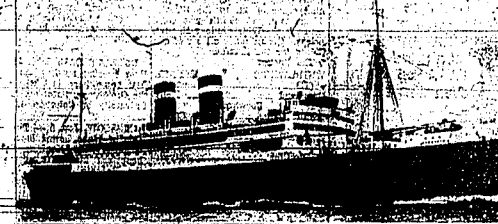

Many Banded Ducks Killed Near Here

Four banded ducks were shot recently on the Snake river or its tributaries near Twin Falls, states W. E. Fritch. A report on the banded ducks just received from the Department shows that the four ducks had been banded at Moyes, Montana.

One of the ducks was shot at Creek Trench, near here, by J. C. Howard. It had been banded September 21, 1917. Two of the ducks had been killed December 17 by J. H. Bean of Twin Falls. They had been banded October 7 and November 16. The other duck reported was killed by L. C. Green, December 15 and had been banded November 6.

The increase in the number of banded ducks in this country hunting territory verifies the contention that the Snake river is the main channel of the ducks.
