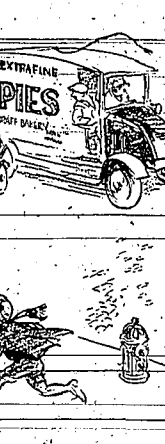

ADJUST YOUR DIET TO STOP FERMENTATION

Dr. Copeland Urges the Study of Foods So That You Can Get, Through Them, the Alkaline Substances Your Digestion Requires.

A FEW days ago I talked with a friend in Washington about health and how to keep it. He spoke about the alkaline waters and various remedies which are prescribed to overcome acidity. My friend is not a doctor, but he is a thinker. In my contacts with him I find he has thought through to logical conclusions many important matters.

In this conversation he pointed out how many persons of his acquaintance suffer from the effects of excess acidity of the system. He is right about it. Many people do suffer a lot from this cause.

Why is acidity so common?

There are two chief reasons:

First—We don't eat regularly of correct combinations of food.

Second—Two million civilized men suffer from constipation. Almost invariably acidity follows. Show me nine persons who are restless and restless at night, who eat their food and then will be the victims of habitual constipation. There is no one thing so productive of disturbed health as constipation.

I know how many of our dominant states are sold every year. The number must be tremendous. It seems to me that a day never passes but I see some one or another for bicarbonate of soda. It is a sight to observe the disagreeable, ugly looking disease of a souring agent.

The vegetables and fruit carry agents which are alkaline producing. Of course, this is not true for all fruits, but it is true for many. If you are unable to eat any fruits, you are at a disadvantage. It is necessary to eat a variety of the alkaline substances your digestion requires.

Fruits, apples and other apples of fruits have juices which contain acids which are not neutralized by the system as a whole. If you eat a large quantity of these fruits, you are likely to have a souring effect on the system.

FREQUENT TRIPS TO DENTIST A BENEFIT

Follow His Advice About the Care of Your Mouth and Gums—As Well as Your Teeth, Says Miss Huddleston.

I CAME away from my dentist office recently with several important, modern hints on the care of the teeth and the hygiene of the mouth, that should prove beneficial to you.

One of the most important of these is that you should brush your teeth five times daily. The first brushing should occur directly upon arising; the second after breakfast; the third after luncheon, the fourth after dinner and the fifth at night, before retiring.

The brush should be selected so that they fit the shape of the teeth, thus cleaning them thoroughly instead of just brushing over them.

The teeth should be brushed up and down instead of side to side. The brush should be bristled and made to bleed. Naturally tooth powder is a matter of individual selection.

Brushing on the market are good and specious and have been prepared for these inclined to acid mouth or yellowish tinge on the teeth.

It is particularly interesting that individuals who suffer from an acid mouth condition either use an acid tooth powder or tooth powder with a weak solution of milk of magnesia at least twice each day. If the acids are not destroyed they form tartar which eventually causes decay and so ruins the enamel.

Frequent rinsing of the mouth with peroxide is a splendid anti-bacterial and helps to keep the teeth white and lustrous.

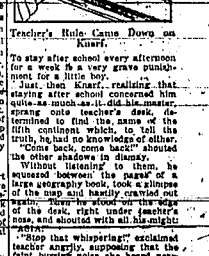

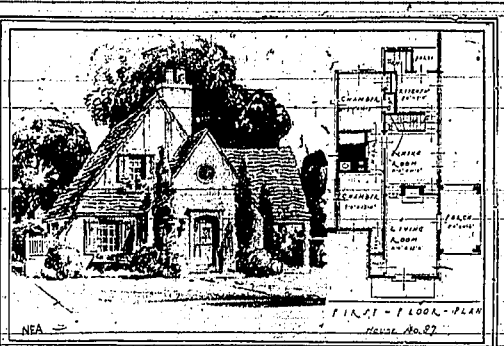

YOU and BASKETBALL

By H. G. CARLSON, M. D., University of Pittsburgh-Basketball Coach

Just as in football, practice is the basis for improvement in basketball. The more you practice, the more accurate in practice, for as you practice, so you play.

In the matter of delivery, there can be greater variety of passes described than for shooting. The ball may be passed and still get away a good pass because of the greater area for the reception of the ball.

For general purposes, I put passes in two classes, a handling pass in the back court for a long pass, and a push pass inside the three-point line.

As in baseball, certain players throw a heavy ball that is hard to handle; other players throw a light ball that is easily handled. Try to throw the ball so that it is already caught.

An easy way to practice passing is by forming two parallel lines 15 feet apart; players facing each other. Practice passing both aerial and bounce, moving about, one step on every other pass, involving accuracy and speed first; then direction by looking one way and passing the other.

As in cutting and passing, stand on the baseline and your feet are in two classes, a handling pass straight across the floor. Your passer will go back of you to your feet, and you will go to your feet.
