SENATOR BORAH REFUSES PLACE IN THE CABINET

Advocative Reports State Idaho's Favorite Can't Accept

ATTORNEY GENERAL IS HARD ONE TO LOCATE

Borah Also Understood to Have Refused the Position of Secretary of State

WASHINGTON, Feb. 21 (UP)—Senator William B. Borah has been tendered the attorney-generalship in the Hoover cabinet and has declined to accept it, the United Press learned today. The news sent to the chairman of the senate foreign relations committee understood to have been secured by President-elect Hoover and Borah declined to take anything that transferred to the new administration. The committee is understood to have declined to relinquish its present position in the senate.

His Hard Time
"I have in touch with the situation," says Hoover, "has been a difficult time filling the attorney-generalship. The friends of the senator have been highly desirable for the post in view of the high senatorial position and the trust law."

Borah is supposed to have been offered the secretaryship of state, the "leading cabinet post," shortly after the election. He is understood to have declined to entertain that proposal either, his present post, of chairman of the senate foreign relations committee being perhaps a more influential office as far as international affairs are concerned.

Obvious speculation turned again today on Henry M. Robinson, Los Angeles banker and close friend of President-elect Hoover, who Robinson held a lengthy conference with Mr. Hoover at the White House today.

Robinson has been mentioned prominently for a cabinet post, but President-elect Hoover has declined to comment on this, as on other cabinet possibilities.
