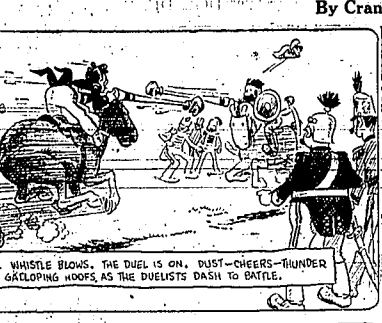
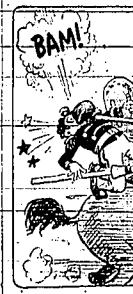

have received unbounded hospitality and courtesy; as their expression of friendliness to the country. We are filled with particular bonds of sympathy and common interest with them. They are men of firm qualities, a special character and a culture which is an impressive contribution to the welfare of the nation. We are proud of the maintenance of their independence, the growth of their stability, and the preservation of their homelands.

It is impossible to prevent those who are in the majority from dominating the whole of the world. Fortunately the new world is largely free from the influences of fear and distrust which have so troubled the old world.

It is impossible, my countrymen, to speak of peace without profound sympathy for the homes in America, in millions of homes around the world, there are vacant chairs. It would be an abandoned confession of our unworthiness if it should develop that we have abandoned the hope for which all these people surely mankind in mature enough so that ought to be permanent peace.

Ahead, to east and west, are nations whose sons mingled their blood with the blood of our sons in the battlefields. Most of our nations have contributed to our race, to our culture, our knowledge and our progress. From out of them we derive our very language and from many of them much of the genius and intelligence which we desire for peace in a deep and sincere as our own.

Peace can be maintained with respect for all in defense. Peace can be promoted by the elimination of all racial and tribal animosities. Peaceful settlement of controversies. But it cannot be a reality only through self-restraint and active effort in friendliness and helpfulness. I covet for this administration a record of having further contributed to advance the cause of peace.

Party Responsibility
 In our form of democracy the expression of the popular will can be effected only through the instrumentalities of party government. We maintain party government not to promote intolerant partisanship but because opportunity must be given for expression of the popular will, and organization provided for the execution of its mandates and for accountability of government to the people.

It follows that the government both in the executive and the legislative branches must carry out the will of the people in such a way which the party government which policies are determined and made chosen to bring them into being. The atmosphere of elections should have no place in our government for government must concern itself alone with the commonweal.

Special Session of Congress
 Action upon some of the proposals upon which the republican party was returned to power, particularly further restrictions, reflect and limited changes in the tariff, cannot in justice to our farmers, our manufacturers and our consumers, be postponed. I shall therefore request a special session of congress for the consideration of these two questions. I shall deal with each of them upon the assembly of the congress.

Mandates from the Election
 It appears to me that the more important further mandates from the recent election were the maintenance of the integrity of the constitution; the vigorous enforcement of the laws; the continuance of economy in public expense.

quality reflects these things of the world to phrases or a catalog of definitions. We do know what the attainments of these ideas should be: the preservation of self government and its full foundations in local government; the perfection of justice whether in economic or in social affairs; the maintenance of ordered liberty; the denial of domination by any group or class; the building up and preservation of equality of opportunity; the stimulation of initiative and individuality; absolute integrity in public affairs; the choice of officials for fitness to office; the direction of economic progress toward prosperity and the further lessening of poverty; the freedom of public opinion; the sustaining of education and of the advancement of knowledge; the growth of self-respect and the tolerance of all faiths; the strengthening of the home; the advancement of peace.

There is no short road to the realization of these aspirations. There is a progressive, but arduous path. No one can achieve with a determination; that progress must be based upon the foundation of self-respect. Our considered remedies for our faults bring only partial relief. It is we men in our mighty past who have created these ideals, we should leave them to be created and strengthened for our children.

Conclusion
 This is not the time and place for casual discussion. The problems before our country are questions of progress to higher standards; they are not the problems of degeneration. They demand and they serve to quicken the conscience and enlist our sense of responsibility for such a settlement. And that responsibility rests upon you, my countrymen, as never as upon those of us who have been selected for office. Ours is a land rich in resources; stimulating in its glorious beauty—filled with millions of happy homes; blessed with countless opportunities. In no nation in our mighty past who have created these ideals, we should leave them to be created and strengthened for our children.

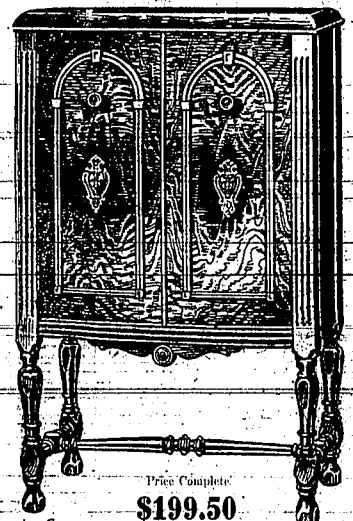
