### Biennial Report

Of R. E. Thomas, State Game Warden  
Tells of the Increase and Decrease of the Game Animals and Birds of This State

The biennial report of the state fish and game warden, R. E. Thomas, is a very comprehensive volume, and adds to our knowledge of the layman's view of the fish and game situation in this state. It makes a number of surprising revelations in regard to the increase and decrease in the numbers of the more common big game animals.

From Alexandria harbor the liners will enter land planes for a trip over lands familiar to the navigator of the Arabian nights. The schedule from Alexandria to the mystic coast calls for halts at Gaza, Beirout, Haifa, Bagdad, Basra, and Bombay.

MURDER THEORY GETS CREDENCE  
Bloodstains on Bridge Over Yellowstone River Lead Police to Doubt Bule's Tale

BILLINGS, Mont., March 30 (AP)—Bloodstains on a pair of sneakers that December 21 on the Yellowstone river led police to believe that Edward Koritzberg, the man charged with the murder of a woman in the river here a week ago.

Discovery of the blood stains on the sneakers was made by J. J. Cruise, another Billings grocer, who reported to county officers. Police, however, had no report of Koritzberg's disappearance and little attention to Cruise's discovery.

### JUDD TIMM RUNS IN RECORD TIME AT TEXAS RELAY

#### Illinois University Track Star Break Several Big Team Records in Big Meet

AUSTIN, Tex., March 29 (AP)—Turning in several record-breaking performances, the Tex track and field team today captured the well in the fifth annual University of Texas relay here yesterday.

The Illinois relay quartet broke the intercollegiate mark in the four mile unitarily relay with a time of 17 minutes 42 seconds, compared with the old title of 17:45 made by Illinois in 1922.

Illinois also took the quarter mile relay when Timm, Burkhardt, Gave and Peterson stepped the pace in 42 seconds, to a new record. Timm built from the bat to take the mile in 1:55 to tie the world record.

Claude Brazier, like instructor Houston, Tex., turned in the outstanding individual performance by running the two yard dash in 25 to tie the world record.

The University of Chicago relay team won both the one mile and two mile unitarily events, setting new meet records in each race. The Chicagoans ran the mile in 1:53.8 seconds and the two miles in 7 minutes, 22.2 seconds.
