FANS TRAMPLED AS CROWD MILLS AT GATES OF PARK

Rain Sends Spectators Into Frenzy of Excitement at Yankee Stadium

OVER 50,000 PERSONS GATHERED IN STADIUM

Babe Ruth Holds Dying Girl in Arms; Wild Disorder Prevails

NEW YORK. May 20 (UPI)—Officials of the New York Yankees said yesterday that the stampede of fans at the gates of the park was due to the rain, which caused the crowd to mill about the street, died shortly after they were injured. At least 20 of the persons who were treated by physicians were said to be in a serious condition.

SHARIF ATTORNEY JOHN H. McGANN of the Bronx said in his investigation showed that there was no negligence on the part of club officials, and that the report that spectators were milled about the gate impossible for the crowd to get out, was unfounded.

Many a man goes limping along, imagining that exposure has caused his muscles and joints to become weaker, and perhaps he has even taken to a sedentary life and game.

Most of us do not realize that such aches of toothiness damage the health.

But the teeth may look perfectly normal and yet be responsible for serious trouble. There may be hidden abscesses at the roots of the teeth.

Every day, if you have the time, you can

find out what the real cause of your misery. Local applications may help, of course, but they will not cure the disease. The treatment, but you cannot expect to be fully relieved until you

have had a thorough examination by a doctor by trying to locate the source of your trouble.

Remember, if you are suffering from toothache, gall-bladder

disease, or some other digestive ailment may be responsible. Find that out, and you will quickly find the real cause of your misery.
