Story of "Murder Farm" Leads to Man's Arrest

CARPENTER IS CHARGED WITH DEATH OF TWO

G. F. Franklin Field in Jail Accused of Killing Wife and Small Son

CHILDREN OF ACCUSED—MAN SIGH COMPLAINT

Scenes of Alleged Crime in California Will be Visited by Authorities

SACRAMENTO, Cal., May 25 (AP)—Arrested of the slaying of his wife and 3-year-old son in 1923 on an alleged "murder farm" near Porterville in Tulare county, G. F. Franklin, 42, piano tuner and carpenter, was held today in county jail here today while officials investigate alleged accusations leveled against the father by his four children.

Meanwhile, officials of Tulare county were scheduled to arrive in Sacramento from Visalia today to gather further evidence in the strange disappearance of Mrs. Franklin and her son. The children who swore to the complete neglect their father was guilty of are 12, 10, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1, and Nellie, 11 months.

From his cell in the county jail today Franklin was interviewed with his daughters, insisting that he had "framed" him. He also insisted he could not see his wife and son were living, as a friend had seen them in Porterville two years ago.

The youth and his three sisters were summoned before Deputy District Attorney Guy P. Johnson yesterday when the story of neglect on the part of their father.

They then related how their mother and young brother had disappeared under mysterious circumstances from the dairy ranch in a remote section of Tulare county.

Franklin left the ranch with his mother and little brother, and children said to place the child under the care of a specialist in Portland. He returned the same day, they said with a bloody axe and sword.

With this new evidence, Tulare county authorities are expected to make a thorough search of the ranch where the crime is alleged to have taken place, and account of the ranch will be exhausted.

The children said they decided to lay the matter to rest, but authorities Sunday night after Franklin returned home in a rage and beat the children. The youth struck his father on the head with a brick, rendering him unconscious, it said.

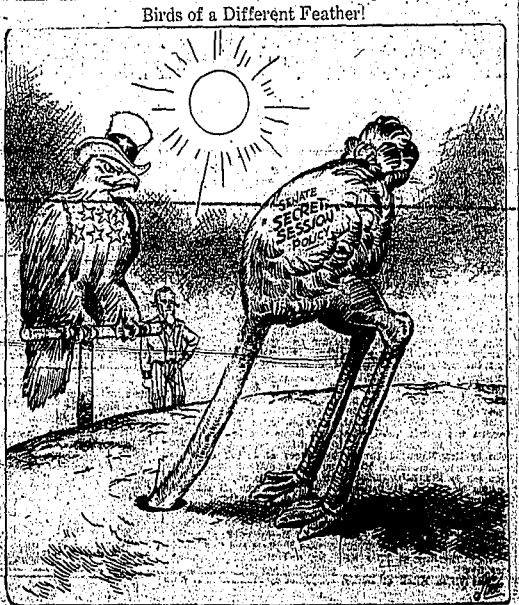

NEW YORK, May 28.—With three western clubs fighting for the lead in the National league early season battles in history, the New York Giants are steadily climbing back in the race. Hitting the crest of a five game winning streak, the Giants face the first crucial test of Saturday. Dazzy Vance and Bill Watter are slated to oppose each other.

This week and week two between the Cubs and Cardinals has been turned into a three cornered affair by Pittsburgh. Taking three straight from the Cards the Pirates have moved into second place, a game behind the Cubs. Half a game behind the Pirates are the Cards.

Through their ability to beat Washington, the Philadelphia Athletics have advanced a three and a half game lead over the St. Louis Browns in the American league. Eleven of the Athletics' 23 victories have been won at the expense of the Senators.

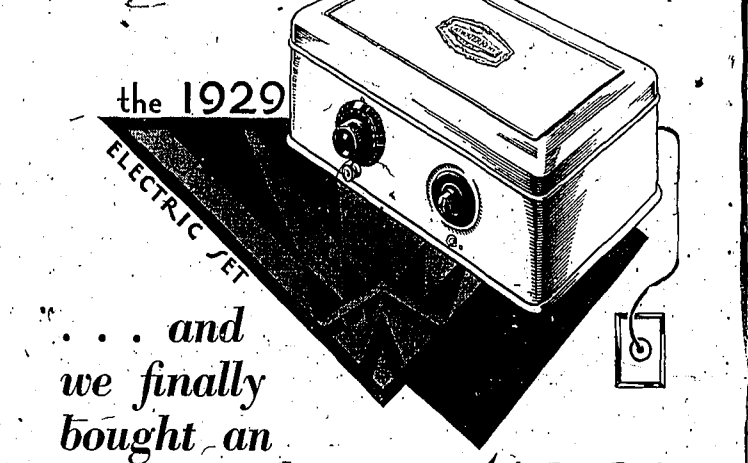

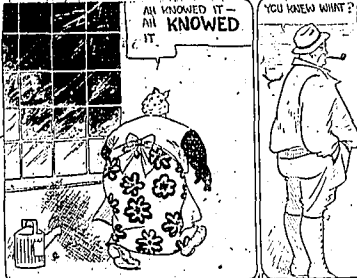

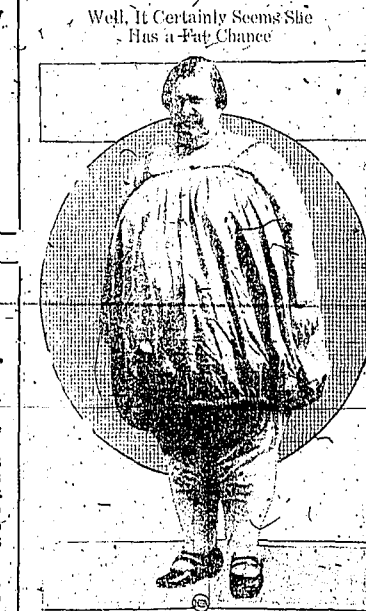
