Many Men Qualify for Indianapolis Event Thursday; Distance of Race is 600 Miles

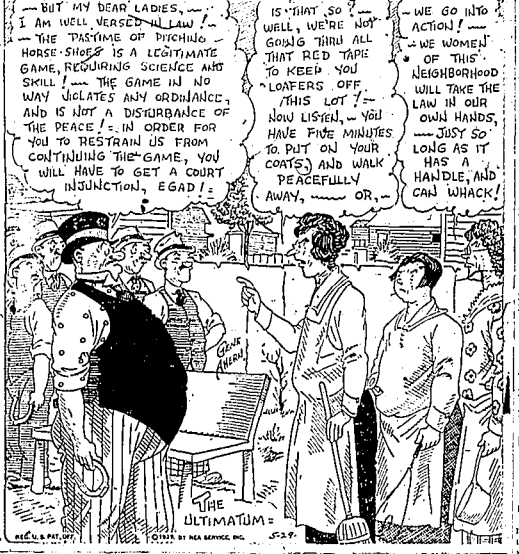
