FOR THE MUTUAL BENEFIT OF TWO IDAHO EMPIRES

The Idaho Free Press in a recent editorial commenting on the value to the Twin Falls district of the Wells cutoff as an outlet for Idaho farm products to California coast markets makes a plea for the extension of a railroad cutoff from the Boise valley to California. The cutoff might be by way of Nampa to Burns and thence either to Klamath Falls or Winnemucca, according to the Nampa newspaper.

In the meantime, we have a suggestion to offer Nampa and the rest of the Boise valley communities that should have benefits for them and for the district south of the Snake river, in the Twin Falls country. Our suggestion is that the Boise valley communities join with us in urging an extension of the Minidoka-Buhl branch to the main line of the Union Pacific across the Snake river.

The Boise valley does not have use of the Wells cutoff now because shipments sent east from that district of the state would have to go to Minidoka, thence back to Twin Falls, involving an extra haul of some 120 miles. But if the Minidoka-Buhl branch were extended, the Boise valley would be just about half the distance from Twin Falls as it is at present.

The Twin Falls district would benefit by such a cutoff by being moved approximately 120 miles closer to Portland and Seattle markets. The main line communities already have such a benefit, but we on the south side of the river do not have it. And we want it. The Boise valley has a chance to move 120 freight miles nearer Northern California, and the Twin Falls country has a chance to move 120 freight miles closer to Portland by extension of the Union Pacific. It strikes us that the project has sufficient appeal for mutual benefits to enlist the hearty support of both sections of the state.
