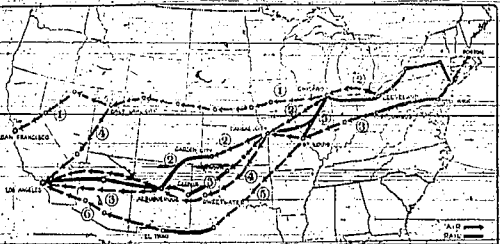

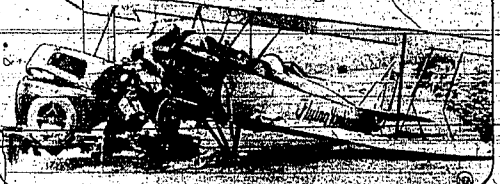


East and West Coasts Now Linked by Six Air-Rail Lines



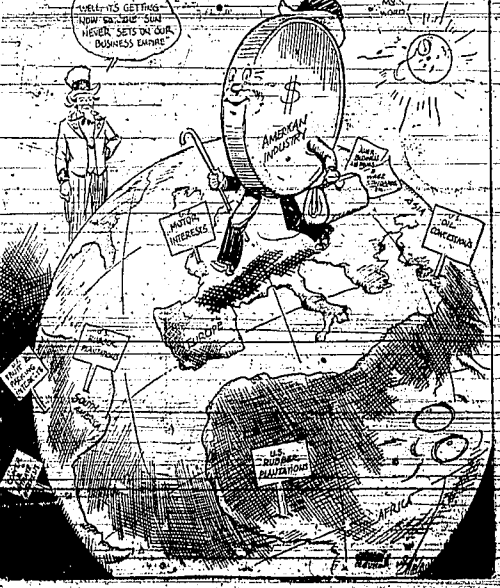
