Of Law Violators

For swift and awful judgments, perhaps no man in history equals Justice Dean. Who, in his 100 years, has meted out justice with a rough class of men—outlaws, horse-thieves and desperados of the early eighties? He made it as clear as possible that they soon learned to fear him. Many seem pinched in the early days of Idaho, and other western states, by the same lawlessness, familiar with his methods, oftenly imitated. In such cases, Mr. Fred Hartman of Idaho, who during his long, rough career, had a hand in the capture of many of the pioneer desperados, referring to the draudle and wholly original methods of dealing with lawbreakers, as practiced by the judge, gave the following example, to which:




