## Tri-Hostess Party Is Pretty Affair

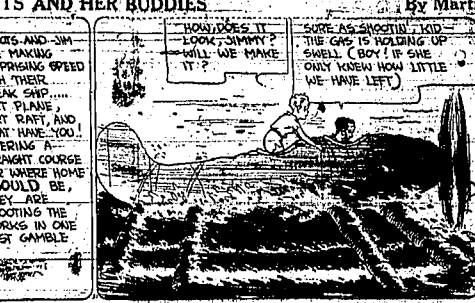
