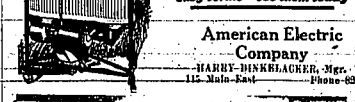

Some time ago we stated in an editorial that the Short Line would probably favor an improved highway along this route now that it had entered the bus business. In discussing the matter with a railroad official recently, he said that irrespective of whether the company was in the bus business or not, he could not see any special advantage to the proposed highway and we are inclined to agree with him in view of the arguments he advanced.

"It is true that the highway would shorten the distance to the western part of the state to some extent but if it is again to be taken into consideration that it would pass through one of the most barren and unproductive areas in the entire state while the main highway now passes through beautiful agricultural areas and modern cities in all directions. Furthermore it is to our advantage to give the tourists an opportunity to see some of Idaho's beautiful productive areas rather than to find the shortest route to get him out of the state, and this route through an area which would be generally through a desert country and not conducive to giving the visitor a favorable impression of Idaho. Let us devote our energies to improving those roads which would make the best tourist and scenic routes rather than to foster highways whose sole benefit would be a matter of eliminating distance. We cannot blame the Short Line for showing little enthusiasm for a highway through a barren waste, and being rather reluctant to bear the greater part of the expense."

THIS HERO BUSINESS
INTERVIEWED after he had dived 48 feet from a bridge over the Tennessee river in Alabama to rescue a companion, Robert Russ, 14, is credited with having made a remark that it takes more nerve to stand up there and rescue than to dive.

Robert is a pitcher as well as a swimmer, so he knew what he was talking about when he made the statement. His team had just been defeated when he made the dive from the bridge to save a companion while other men looked on helplessly, the United Press report stated.

In a very real sense Robert undoubtedly was right in his statement. Many of what we call heroic deeds are conceived and executed with little delay. To stand the gaff when every instant calls for the maximum of one's courage and the making of never resolves in a sense does require more of the doer who is performing the commonplace work than of the hero in an emergency.

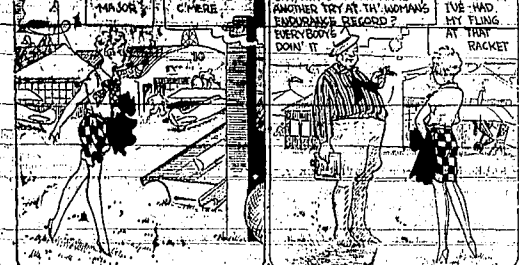

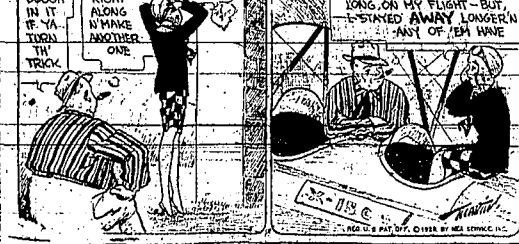
