THE LAW HELPED DID you see the item that is reprinted below? It was published in Monday's paper on page three in the "Local News in Brief" department. The item read:

It goes without saying that some who read will say the case is trivial. And so it is, judged by ordinary standards of values, but by other standards, it is extraordinarily significant.

What was at stake in this case? One doll dress, its value? Nominal. But was the value nominal? Did not that doll dress have a value to the little girl greater than most women would put on party dresses? It was her dress only by proxy. Actually that dress belonged to her dolly, and little girls love dollys with real devotion.

The dress was taken. The girl said a boy had taken it, probably a playmate—a boy with a flair for teasing, we might surmise. But he failed and refused to bring the dress back. That created a tragic situation—a dolly was without her rightful dress.

What to do? Call the police and enlist their aid. The little foster mother reasoned—She did call the police. Whether they considered the case trivial we are not informed, but it is everlastingly to their credit that they heeded her request with sympathy and consideration and returned her property to her.

Officers are real friends of boys and girls. Too many children do not realize this because the threat of the officers being called to punish them has created in childish minds fear of officers. The little girl in this episode knew officers as friends. And they proved their friendship.

Yes, it is quite war-rum, but remember the beans!

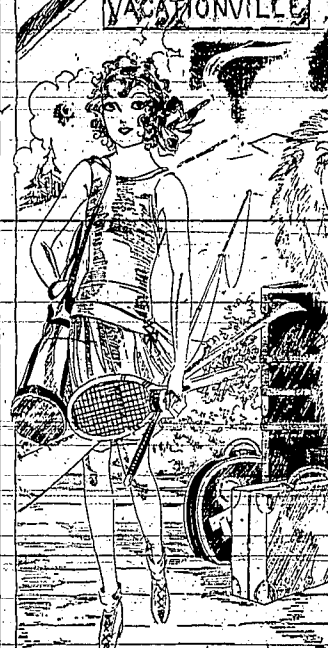

SOVIET REGIME TESTS PEASANTS IN FAKE REVOLT

Man in Uniform of White Guards Descend Upon Village; People Are Aroused

MOSCOW (U.P.)—At least one "fake" revolt against the Soviets has been admitted, and admitted with some pride, by the Soviet press here.

It happened in the village of Noshchenka, in the Kassyk district of Siberia, a district that comprises all too vividly the horrors of civil strife which drained Siberia in blood in the first years of the Revolution. Like a thousand other places which carry the wounds of those years, Noshchenka has jumped nearly to the subject of revolts and counter-revolts.

It jumped with all alertness one night recently when a group of "Whites," in the uniforms of the "White" army, descended upon the village while it slumbered peacefully.

The invaders went about their job quietly and efficiently. They awakened a leading Communist, informed him that the "White" force was under arrest, and that he was under arrest.

They made the same announcement, in turn, to one after another of the important Communists and social workers, gradually gathering a considerable "number," mostly in neighboring villages.

The triumphant "Whites" were especially interested in reaching the village of Noshchenka, and they went to bed as rulers and awake prisoners of war out of the rebelled area.
