PRESERVING BEAUTY

ONE difference that exists as between  
natural attractions of but some have  
natural attractions galore and others have  
none—and must develop them or go  
without.

It is trite to say that the Twin Falls  
community is blessed with a rich abundance  
of natural beauty spots. So great  
is our abundance, in fact, that we some-  
times need to have our appreciation of  
them sharpened by the enthusiasm of  
those who fall into the habit of tak-  
ing our beauties for granted.

The advantage of having natural  
beauty spots is of such great import as  
nearly to be subject to appraisal. It  
would be dispense with our gifts from  
Nature if we did not then

begin to appreciate just how for-  
tunate we are for us that we have so  
bountifully blessed.

It follows logically that since we have  
been the recipients of so much beauty  
we should guard and preserve it with  
loving care.

The natural gifts are that we do not  
fully realize the degree we should.

The next time you go to the Twin  
Falls Jerome bridge walk out on the  
bridge and gaze at the slope from the  
timber rock just west of the structure.

That slope is covered with garbage,  
junk and trash of every description,  
including large paper cartons. The  
natural beauty of the slope is ruined by  
the presence of all that man discarded.

regular dumping ground is an eye sore  
because someone had no appreciation  
whatever of natural beauty and was  
completely lacking in civic pride.

UNPREPARED IN THE AIR?

Despite all the progress America  
has made in aviation in recent years,  
the nation cannot yet consider itself  
properly prepared in the air, in a military  
sense, according to Rear Admiral W. A. Moffett, chief of aeronautics in  
the U. S. navy.

Admiral Moffett told Culver Military  
academy summer school students the  
other day that Germany, despite  
her defeat in the World War, leads the  
entire world in aviation, "both in ex-  
penditures and progress." He urged  
an upbuilding of Uncle Sam's aerial  
defense, remarking that the navy needs  
at least four more modern aircraft  
carriers.

Probably it is a surprise to most of us to hear that our military aviation is  
not yet up to standard. There is one  
comfort, however; we are undoubtedly  
making vast progress. The quick de-  
velopment of a huge air force in time  
of war would be a far easier task now  
than it was in 1917.
