CUBS LIKELY TO SET NEW RECORD FOR ATTENDANCE

New York Yankees Hold Present Record But Chicago Team Is Going Strong Now

CHICAGO, Sept. 3 (UP)—It now seems almost certain that the Chicago Cubs will set a new attendance record for the end of the 1929 season. The present high mark is held by the New York Yankees who in one year played to an aggregate of about 1,250,000 persons but the Cubs appear to be destined to better that mark and reach 1,500,000.

The greatest indication of the Cubs' remarkable drawing power was given on Sunday afternoon when approximately 50,000 fans filled the stadium.

Chicago team had dropped four out of five games to the Pittsburgh Pirates.

Previous to this year, it was believed that the Yankees, with their great seating capacity would continue to hold the record, despite the fact that the Cubs were not productive of an attendance record.

However, that attendance records appear almost certain now as the Cubs seem destined to play to at least 10,000 more than the Yankees record of 1,250,000.






