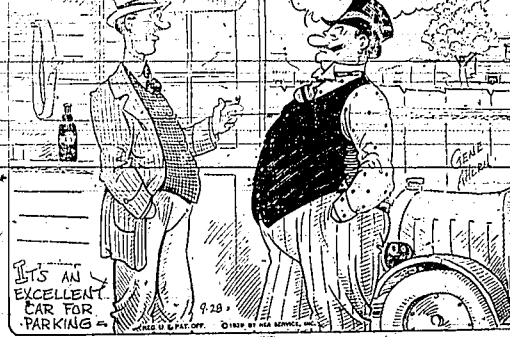

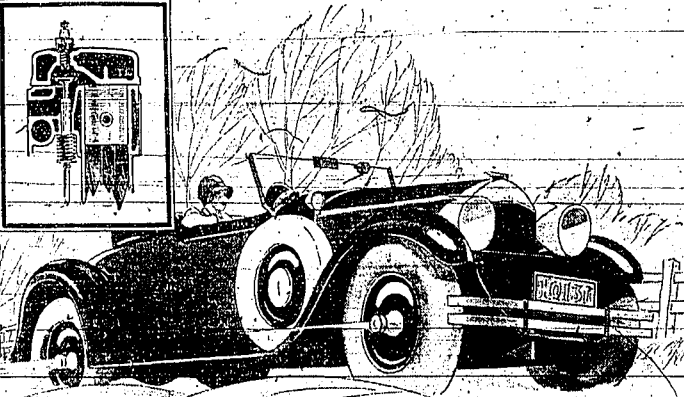

But, after all, who cares? There is a do-or-die spirit that makes up for all errors. Players and spectators alike are on fire with energy. The atmosphere is electric.

There is one queer feature about watching a high school game, though. Before the thing is over you are apt to find a mist coming into your eyes now and then, a lump rising to clog your throat.

For the high school kids have something that we other ones have pretty well lost—something that they themselves will lose in a few years. They have enthusiasm.

Now this youthful enthusiasm is going to be spoiled in a few years. It can't last. But while it lasts its possibilities are infinite.

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WISDOM MADE NO DIFFERENCE. SENTIMENT is sometimes figured as playing a too great part in trials where wealthy persons are involved, and it is likely to be a source of renewed confidence in the integrity of juries that in California a few days ago a wealthy woman charged with causing the death of a man of foreign birth was found guilty.

A young man, charged with killing his wife on the first anniversary of their marriage, was also found guilty. The factor of wealth did not enter into his case, but he did admit to the act of causing his wife's death, and the circumstances attendant on the killing were such that a sentimental jury might have found cause to give him his freedom.

We need no tyranny, either of wealth or of poverty, of the aristocratic few or the humble many. We need unadorned justice, applied fairly, irrespective of the station of the defendant.

THE LONE WOLF Did you notice that news story the other day that told of the finding of a savings of more than \$20,000 that had been hoarded by a watchman and was found after his death by an honest landlady?

It seems odd that such hoarding of wealth should be practiced in this day and age of the world's development, but incidents come to light regularly enough to make us aware that hoarding still has its devotees.

What happens when wealth is hoarded? Several things. The person doing the hoarding brands himself as a lone wolf of society. He can trust no one except himself as to the hiding place of his savings, or it might be stolen from him if he dies before recovering his savings.

After all, wealth can not be owned individually, in a strict sense of the word. An individual may be worth \$10, \$10,000, or \$10,000,000 as we compute such things, but he shares his wealth with others. Does he own a fine hotel? We share in it, we in the community, in greater or less degree. He owns it, but we share it. Does he own a factory, a big mercantile establishment, a bank? Title may be vested in him so clearly as to satisfy a whole battery of lawyers, yet we, his fellow citizens, share with him in the benefit of this property he owns.

A man who has \$20,000 in cash and has it at work, whether in a bank in a savings account, or in mortgages, bonds, stocks, life insurance or what not, is helping society. He collects rent in the form of interest earnings, but his dollar are working if he is not a lone wolf, a hoarder.

It he is a hoarder, his chances of loss are actually greater than if he used the ordinary conventional means of depositing, or investing, and he also deprives society of any legitimate advantages of his wealth. Co-operation is still one of the greatest forces in everyday living.
