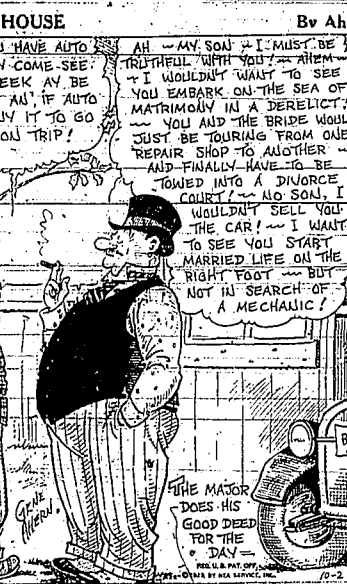

Best Editorial of the Day GASOLINE COSTS IDAHO MORE THAN NEIGHBOR STATES

The Idaho title acquisition is considered that freight rates on gasoline shipped into the state of Idaho are unreasonable, unjust and unfair. BOISE, Oct. 3 (UP)—Idaho's 1929 potato crop will net 10 to 15 per cent, by recent frosts, reports L. C. Schultz, federal inspector with the state department of horticulture, who has just returned from a two weeks' inspection tour throughout southern Idaho and western Montana.
