OREGONIANS ARE URGED TO DO AS IDAHO HAS DONE

Former Idahoan Tells Men At Burns, Oregon, Chamber of Commerce How to Develop

Some Oregon farmers are being urged to follow the example of Idahoan farmers in their practice in relation to a real estate, according to a word received from Mrs. J. G. Wilson, Oregon, Chamber of Commerce, Burns, Oregon. Mrs. Wilson said the following, following from an Oregonian, who is selling an address by William Hanley to the Chamber of Commerce. Mr. Hanley was formerly in this section and the report of his speech is as follows: "I have been engaged in agriculture in Idaho, and Idaho, which has been virtually an entire growth in an agricultural way during the past 25 years, are really in the same boat, and the time has come when we should all take a lesson from each other."

This was the declaration of William Hanley Tuesday in a short address before the Chamber of Commerce at the Hotel Williams. Mr. Hanley urged Oregon to take one of the largest land owners in the Harney basin, but just returned from a 10-day tour in southern Idaho.

"That's a trip that every one of us that is connected with development here should take," Mr. Hanley asserted, "with practically the same country we have here they have developed one of the finest agricultural countries in America, all in 25 years and they have lots of people and they're prosperous."

They have the same railroad, too, the Idaho Pacific. And let me say, there isn't a better railroad for agricultural development than that one. "We need to know and to use the methods in bringing our own country into its own. One of the first things we want to do is get some of Idaho's experienced irrigation people in here for leadership. Irrigation is a different line that we have here following and they can do us and themselves a lot of good in here."

YELLOWSTONE IN SECOND POSITION STATISTICS SHOW

Yellowstone's Waterfalls Worn Greater Lure Than Yosemite's Geysers This Year

By HARRY W. FRANTZ, United Press Staff Correspondent, WASHINGTON (UP)—Yosemite National Park was a more potent lure than Yellowstone geysers in the annual race for tourists in 1929, according to statistics published by the department of interior.

Work in the travel year ending Oct. 31, 1929, compared with 402,319 in the previous year, while Yellowstone gained in relative popularity with 265,622, against 228,184 in the year before.

Although Yosemite maintained its first place, any apprehensions along the Yellowstone trail will tell you that Yosemite has a longer season and it's easier to reach cities, and that Old Faithful still is the first and last love of the true "scenery tramp."

The total number of visitors to national parks in 1929 was 2,650,597 against 2,522,183 in 1928, in addition to 1,000,000 in the previous year.

The figures showed conclusively that the travelers' desire to "see America first" has not abated by the terrific draw of the power which has been along the line.

The big feature of the park travel year were increases in travel to Yellowstone, Sequoia, Crater Lake, Glacier, Rocky Mountain and Grand Canyon.

Eleven of the parks showed a hundred percent increase this year.
