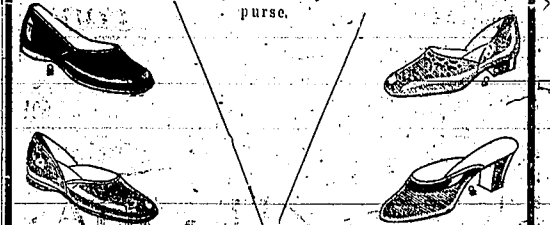

Hoover Lays Groundwork for Survey of Child Health

KELLY ACCEPTS LEADERSHIP OF 2 DEPARTMENTS

Sweeping investigation of the conditions will be made. Adequate funds available.

UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO, MOSCOW, Oct. 28.—President Kelly announced today that he will accept the leadership of the greatest survey ever attempted in the United States over child health and protection.

The survey will be conducted by Dr. F. J. Kelly, president of the University of Idaho, upon his return from Washington, D. C., where he attended the White House conference on child health and protection.

President Kelly has accepted the chairmanship of the section on education and training in this significant move.

meant, which will constitute the united efforts of at least 150 national authorities on child welfare.

The child welfare program is sponsored by the National Child Health Council, which is headed by Hoover because of his intense personal interest in the field. He called the council together at Washington about thirty leading authorities in the United States on various phases of child welfare and protection.

These representatives have been organized into a planning committee which outlined the program. It is a general survey program to cover the entire United States.

The various surveys will have several hundreds of thousands of dollars available to purchase their activities, which will be of the highest quality.

After the first report is made, which will be in about six months, the committee will narrow the field to certain particular aspects to which major attention is to be given.

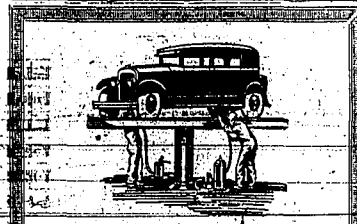

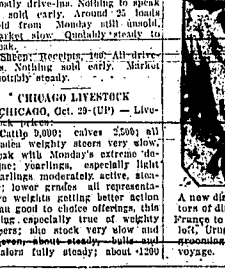

Plan Distance Flight Over Sea

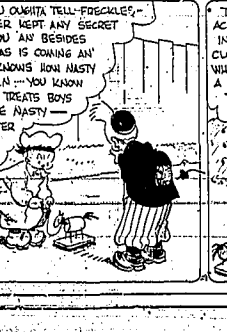
