MEXICAN REGIME TAKES STEPS TO PROTECT VOTERS

Political Rioting in Yucatan, Siders Government to Encourage Activity

MANY BRAP CLASHES TAKE PLACE RECENTLY

Three Wounded in a Pistol Fight in Oaxaca at Vera Cruz

MEXICO CITY, Nov. 12 (UP)—Suffered further bloodshed in political riots at Vera Cruz, Leon, Guanajuato and Merida, Yucatan. The federal government prepared to enforce by military procedure its recent ruling against the Mexican presidential election next Sunday. Within 24 hours after Sunday's violent riot in Mexico City, reports were received of the wounding of 15 persons in clashes outside the capital. These followers of Pascual Ortiz Rubio, administration candidate for the presidency, were reported wounded in a pistol fight with supporters of the anti-revolutionist candidate, Jose Vasconcelos, in a cafe at Vera Cruz. Official advisers to the department of the interior said clashes had occurred between the Vasconcelos and Ortiz Rubio followers in Leon, Guanajuato and Merida, Yucatan.
