IDAHO TO WAGE WAR ON NOXIOUS WEED IN SPRING

Plumbers' Virus Causing All Sorts of Trouble in Our State, Authorities' Claim

NOBLES Nov. 13 (Special)—Arrangements have been made whereby an active campaign will be made to eradicate the destructive plague which has been reported growing in several sections of Idaho. The announcement was made by L. P. Parsons, secretary of the state chamber of commerce.

Mr. Parsons stated that arrangements had been made with the University of Idaho through Dean E. J. Iddings of the College of Agriculture, whereby the Agricultural Extension Division will inaugurate a campaign in the program of eradication of noxious weeds.

"Extensive work will not start until spring but in order that it may be effective and complete preliminary surveys will be made in all parts of the state which will have to be done in advance. Mr. Parsons has addressed a letter to the secretaries of all chambers of commerce in the state asking them to cooperate in this project by determining in what portions of the state the weed is found. He requested that each chamber assign one of its members to make a survey and send in the results either by state chairman or by state chairman to the state chairman at Moscow.

Among the objectionable features of this weed pest are: "Puncture automobile tires; makes hay unpalatable; causes mouth sores; injures hooves of cloven-footed animals; roasts grade of hay and wool; menace to bare-footed children; creates local irritations on movement of farm products; and is reported to be the cause of great animal losses to agriculture and automobiles."

"It behooves Idaho to start this campaign against the invasion of the state which is spreading further," writes Mr. Parsons.

A year ago this weed contributed to the possible loss of life within our boundaries. An airplane from the California alighted on one of our airports with fuel exhausted. In the "puncture" weed in landing the wing of the plane was wrecked. The pilot, prevented a fatal accident."

NEGRO DEMOCRATS MAY BE SELECTED

WASHINGTON, Nov. 13 (UP)—Plans for election of negro congressmen were announced today by Louis Chicago and New York were discussed with vice-president James A. Arnold, vice president of the southern tariff association, letters uncovered by the senate investigating committee today indicated.

The proposal to elect negro congressmen was part of a general plan outlined in documents found by committee investigators in Arnold's office. It was a "southern republican council" to hold the gains made by republican party in the south in the last election.

Arnold's alleged visit to Curtis was described in a letter he wrote to co-sponsor Vance. The letter follows in part: "I want with the darkest Italy to be thought well of our negro congressman. I don't believe it was a matter that should be taken up with Mr. Hoover and that he would talk with Hoover about it."

The letter said Curtis thought the solution of the negro problem was to get a better line of negroes to lead the south.

"But our line of approach is more acceptable and to negroes of equalizing by blackening the democrat party than whitening the republican party," Arnold wrote.

He was not injured. His brother, Joseph Brenner, had been negotiating with the kidnapers but it was not known what terms, if any, had been agreed upon.

The kidnapers who held Brenner had threatened his life if the ransom was not paid. Several messages were received from the captured man, asking that payment of ransom be made quickly. One offer of \$20,000 was made to the kidnapers who were believed to be Russian.

A Russian girl was arrested by police on charges of acting as a decoy for the kidnapers.

NEW AIR LINERS WILL BE BUILT

NEW-YORK, Nov. 13 (UP)—Atlantic flying liners almost beyond the comprehension of the layman soon will be built in the United States to carry 600 or more passengers across the Atlantic at terrific speeds, Harry Westcott, president of an engineering firm, said today.

Westcott said that within the last 20 days his company had received a request from an American, the identity of which he refused to reveal but on the structural work for a flying boat capable of transporting 600 passengers and 100 crew between London and New York in 10 hours.

The multi-motored ship, which will dwarf even the Lusitania D.O.X. which recently carried 165 persons on a test flight in Sweden, will have a total of 20,000 horsepower, the engineer said, and German power experts have been called in by the American

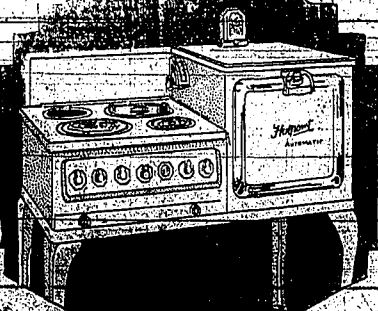

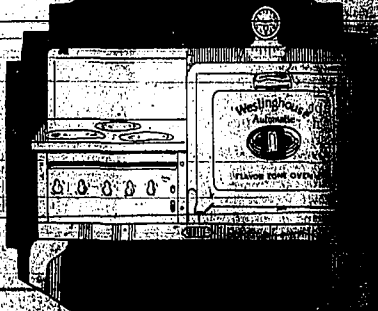

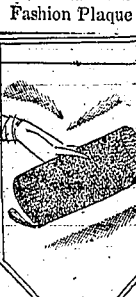
