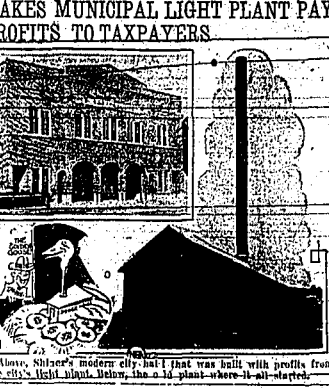
TEXAS TOWN NOW MAKES MUNICIPAL LIGHT PLANT PAY BIG PROFITS TO TAXPAYERS

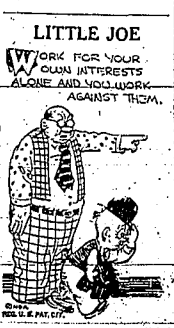

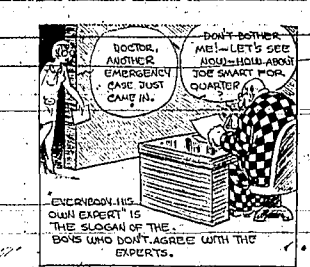

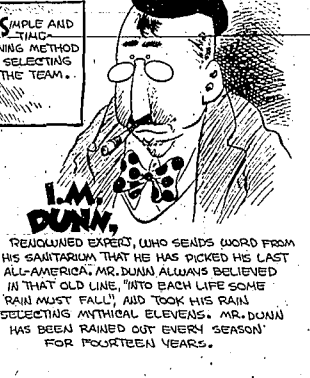

YOUTHFUL SLAYER GOES TO DEATH IN HAWAIIAN ISLANDS

HONOLULU, T. H. (UP)—Myles Fukunaga, the Hawaiian of Hawaii, died on the gallows of his crime today for the murder of 10-year-old Jim Jamieson...

The 28-year old Japanese was slain before daylight to receive a special mass celebrated by Father Francis Zorn. He was obviously nervous and frightened.

Witnesses to the execution including territorial police officials and newspapermen were assembled in front of the prison at 7 a. m.

Shortly before 8 a. m., a military sheriff, John C. Lane, read the death warrant to the condemned youth. In the death cell and a few seconds later the youth walked to the gallows room.

Fukunaga started the march to the gallows at 8:14 a. m. One minute later the trap was sprung and the youthful slayer went to his death.

The crime for which Fukunaga was hanged was the abduction and murder of the Jamieson youth, son of Frederick Jamieson, vice president of the Hawaiian Trust company.

He failed to return to his home in Puna, Hawaii, the afternoon of Sept. 18, 1933. That evening the father received a telephone call asking that \$10,000 be taken to a captain residence.
