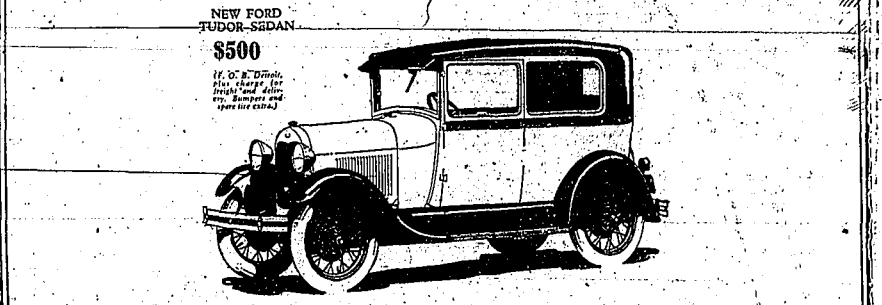

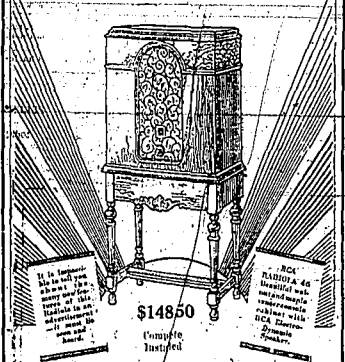

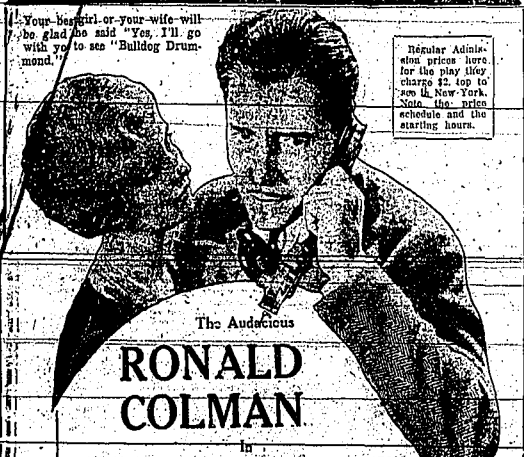

MCKELVIE TALKS TO FARM UNION

CHICAGO, Nov. 22 (UP)—The American farmer is the most efficient in the world, but the system of distribution which obtains here, says McKelvie, is not efficient. Former Governor Samuel H. McKelvie told delegates at an annual meeting of the National Farmers' union here.

McKelvie, who is a member of President Hoover's federal farm board, explained the four methods which the board intends to use in the future to help the farmer on a party with industry.

The methods are, he said: (1) by maintaining special credit; (2) by preventing inefficient and wasteful methods of distribution; (3) by increasing cooperative marketing systems and (4) by preventing and controlling surpluses of agricultural products.

Identifies Silver Polish As Poison

CHICAGO, Nov. 22 (UP)—Whoever poisoning of Chicago's streets with silver polish and flycatchers for 18 months, has been traced by the health department to the use of sodium cyanide in silver polish.

"A thin film of polish, ten or fifteen times thicker than ordinary silver polish, is thick enough to make the diner, deathly sick, according to Health Commissioner Arnold Berg. The latest report of poisoning—from this source comes from the Madhavi clinic, which where it is a required medical attention after a banquet."

Dr. Kegel said 400 Chicagoans had been poisoned in the last 18 months by sodium cyanide crystals which had been left on silverware in Chicago cafes, hotels and clubs. He has forbidden the use of silver polish containing the poison.
