New Technique Is Needed To Handle Western Domains

Washington, Nov. 23 (UP)—Invention of a new technique for handling the 100,000,000 acres still remaining in the Federal Government's vast western domain is essential, Secretary of Interior William J. Clegg said today. Finding the initial session, the 21 members, representing western states, heard an outline of the problem presented by Clegg and James H. Garfield, chairman. Water is the measure of progress in western states, Clegg said, and he urged the necessity for developing methods of conserving and using the available water supply of the public lands. Population of many western states he added, has now reached its limit unless new water resources are developed. Four major problems emphasized before the committee by Garfield were: (1) Grazing, (2) Reclamation, (3) Water power, (4) Oil. Clegg committed for each of these subjects were to be selected by the commission. The 25,000,000 acre, power rich of the mountains in New York may be seen by miles.
