Explorer, Sentenced to Leavenworth from Texas, Looking Forward to Freedom



LEAVENWORTH, Wash., Dec. 27 (UPI)—A grey-haired doctor of medicine from San Jose, Calif., serving in the federal prison here today was perhaps a flutter of the heart rattling the thrill he gave when he said he would be the first to reach the North Pole. Dr. Frederick A. Cook, "Smiling Cook," who was a world's record holder in a solo flight over mountains and seas, Cook entered

Leavenworth yesterday April 25, the tenth anniversary of President Wilson's entry into the war, to serve six years and three months, plus a fine of \$10,000.

On March 5, 1929, he will be eligible to parole, the federal parole board will sit in its judge's room between Jan. 10 and 15, between which dates he will be transferred to the United States today.



SPUD SHIPMENTS REPORTED LIGHT

except Sunday. Shipments from 8,144 cars, 3819 having moved Idaho for the last ten days to date, since the Derby-Twin Falls section, 2,535 cars, had Idaho ships entirely except Sunday. Shipments from the state continued to roll well-Sunday section and Northern Idaho. On the same date as last week, during the first season, the state had shipped 4,024 east to Cheyenne, south to Pueblo, 2,414 to Denver, 1,000 to Salt Lake City, west to Arizona, Southern California, Northern California and 463 from the Idaho Falls section toward north Montana and the Idaho Falls section, with about 1,000 cars in the state with this range taking on a few cars.

Normal Fall

Shipments from Idaho at the demand for Idaho potatoes was only fair during the greater part of the period. The market was held by the potato dealers, who had a large amount of medium sized potatoes held through other channels during this period at prices that ranged from a slight loss to cash. Growers in general did not follow the precedent of mid-December trading by holding a large amount of produce to track warrenings. Idaho was exceptionally light this season.

LITTLE PRICE CHANGE.

Cash track prices on number one bushels in the Idaho Falls market last week closed at \$1.85. Two bushels were \$3.50. The two showed very little decline opening at \$1.10-1.15 and closing at \$1.10 with an occasional car of higher quality. Market price for number one bushel was \$1.75-1.80.

A better undertone prevailed in the market in some spots early in the week. Trade in the more important markets of the country were in the aggregate at their lowest level of the season. Demand was rather light in most of the markets, but there was a tendency to improve in the market in the West, beginning to inquire for potatoes and the market firming up a shade at some points. Inquiry at Idaho Falls was very little though daily toward the end of this period, but the bulk of these requests were for potatoes at prices below current quotations, so that trading remained rather slow.
