THOUGHT it a royal road to romance in everyday life, but it is not a beaten track. No man, no woman, no child, nor any other individual can make a road for himself, and that only you might, for it leads from your dreams to your dreams.

—A road to adventure, can be an ardent adventure, too; can be a love adventure in your own imagination, you cannot find it on the street or in the desk drawer, but it is there, waiting, that wherever you go, you find only what you take with you.

Adventure is not just a name,

it is a way of life, and it need not require exploring strange lands or living among strange peoples. It simply means satisfying the imagination in whatever you may be doing.

The Dream of Adventure

I have waded adventure in old, old books, I have seen it in art, but this is my interpretation of what constitutes adventure. I find a scientist can have the most exciting experience without ever leaving his laboratory, and that, at the same time, he can have high adventure seeing the blue birds depicted in brick and stone.

I have many, many, many dreams come true, and since we

weave our destinies out of different threads, we naturally mix different colors, and when we mix all interpretations of the word "adventure," no matter where we go, Romance never can be stereotyped. It is always an "individual" experience.

The most happily endowed person is the one who can dramatize himself into a big part, no matter how insignificant his role and, secondly, the one who can create an atmosphere of adventure, can furnish color and flavor to his existence, no matter where he goes. Such a man will lead an adventure-filled life, and for him, adventure is the formula in his own head.

It's Yesterdays That Counts

I am not a dreamer for the mother who rises above the routine and sees herself as a dreamer of the human race and a custodian of the world's future. She is the mother in the scheme of things.

The man who drills oil fields, drives a truck, or makes a living by robbing banks is not ready for hangs.

In the adjoining document room, however, between 500 and 1,000 men are dead, were maimed and probably ruined.

Planting and harvesting does not seem exciting unless the farmer has, the vision of the day, the maintenance of the nation. He is a vital part in the human machine, without which we should all perish.

A son who only scrub docks, has a "lowly" job, but he senses the romance of the port he serves, and the romance of the sea, the stars, and the waves, romance and adventure are his.

Finds Romance After Work

I must admit that I do not feel the romance of the oil fields, and in the people who have lived as I have. To find romance, I have to turn back—the oil-driller and the oil-field worker.

I know there's romance in America. I know there are equal opportunities for all, and the less thousands who are finding themselves drawn without the aid of railroads, ocean liners and airplanes. But I am not one of them.

Perhaps I am, too, but I am not the oil-driller, the oil-field worker, the oil-field supervisor. Perhaps I have never grown up sufficiently to appreciate the millions close to home. I have had a few years with oil, past before I am ready for the present.

I KNOW I can't see the sky-line of the oil fields in my imagination. But oil, in Mayan temples or a scrumming pyramid, moves me profoundly.

This is easily explained. In my case, it goes back to my childhood, when my dreams were formed. I was born in a small town in Oregon, and Oregon gave me a sense of the West, of the mountains, of the forests, of the rivers, of the streams, of the lakes, and of the people who live in them.
