

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WESTERN STATES DECLARED SOURCE OF MUCH ALCOHOL

Washington, Jan. 9. (UP)—Western farm states, producers of which have started a new prohibition force in the senate by asking an enforcement bill, are the chief source of illicit liquor, federal prohibition authorities here believe.

Corn fields of Idaho, Nebraska, and other western and midwestern states which have been sold illegally dry, are held to constitute the source of the raw material in the manufacture of thousands of gallons of illegal whisky by bootleggers.

Industrial alcohol manufacturers, which western creators have declared is being tapped by bootleggers for large supplies of alcohol.




