DISPATCHES from Washington indicate that William B. Shearer will be barred from Great Britain if he attempts to horn his way into the forthcoming naval disarmament conference at London.

This is very good news. There seems to be a good deal of haziness about the exact nature of Shearer's activities at the last conference, but there is little reason to doubt that he was sent there to toss a monkey wrench into the proceedings if he could, and he did his blatant best to fulfill his mission.

How much influence the man may have had is another question. However, there is no use in taking any chances. His sole role at such an affair seems to be that of troublemaker. If, by the United States and Great Britain, will be much better off if Shearer is kept at least 2000 miles away from London while the conference is in session.

PARTIES AND ISSUES

Bailey Times

Chairman Robbie of the Democratic state committee is asking members of his party to sign up on issue on which to wage the next campaign in Idaho. He is asking too much. There is no such issue and under present conditions there can be none. There is no distinct line of cleavage between Republicans and Democrats today in Idaho or elsewhere. There is no issue in sight that would command the united support of either Republicans or Democrats.

The common definition of Democrat is one who believes in the welfare of the people, in the right of self-government, in the right of a sovereign or autonomous unit, believes in strict construction of the Constitution, in the rights of the states.

The common definition of Republican is one who believes in free popular government, opposition to classes, free ballot for all voters of proper age under constitutional restrictions; liberal construction of the Constitution, especially in the direction of federal power.

Only by expert juggling of words can any one succeed in attempting to appear to mean these two definitions.

On the questions that are now uppermost Republicans should line up for a high tariff; Democrats for a low tariff; Republicans for enforcement for the prohibition law, even if it called into action the full power of the army and navy; Democrats for repeal of the Volstead act and re-enactment of the question of states; Democrats should fight the government by bureaus and commissions; they should not bring over-green federal power to protect us from foreign competition, but will always hang on and dominate.

There will not, because neither party can line up all its forces behind any one of these issues. The pre-dominance of the Republicans in Congress now on the frontier is an illustration. If the Democrats were in power, and proposed a tariff, the Democrats were to apply their fundamental principles of state rights to the protection issue, they would lose half of their members. And so it goes.

Another fact, which should not be overlooked, is that not always are mistakes rectified, even when uncovered. We have a right to find satisfaction in the fact that this situation has been handled "in a constructive manner" in Twin Falls county. If ever further action is needed, it appears we may count on it being taken.
