LONDON, Jan. 23. (UPI) - The United States may be reduced. Secretary of State Henry L. Stimson told the five-power naval conference here that national requirements are largely relative; Stimson said at the first audience session, and therefore, if the conference finds a basis for a new American strength could be cut.

No Statement Made

the private session of the conference was devoted to a general explanation by the chief delegates of the naval requirements of their countries.

The five-power naval conference, however, ignored the "tonnage requirements."

Each spoke in general terms, according to the press.

After the conference, the American delegation, headed by Stimson, will make an official recommendation to the state that all naval operating bases and ports be made available to maintain a fleet of two men.

"We are not yet in a position to say whether we shall be able to make a declaration."
