IDAHO POTATO SHIPPERS NEED WEEVIL ROOMS

Requirements of Several States Regarding Weevil Protection Set Forth By M. L. Dean and Approved by J. Welch

Many Idaho potato shippers last year had storage but no weevil rooms, states E. V. Gipson, director of the requirements. It has been reported by M. L. Dean, director of the bureau of plant industry, and approved by John S. Welch, commissioner of agriculture, that the outline prepared by them is submitted as follows by Mr. Gipson:

The outline that potato shippers and dealers may be familiar with the requirements of the states of Arizona, California, Nevada, Minnesota, New Mexico, Washington and that part of Oregon west of Baker, in relation to the acceptance of shipments of Idaho potatoes, when compared with the Idaho outline, which we wish to call your attention to the requirements regarding the securing of such certificates, which are issued by inspectors. The requirements must be fulfilled by shippers in advance of loading operation in order that they can examine the cars before receiving them from alfalfa hay, other hay, cereal straw, inspectors should examine the floor tracks and rails, and all cars to be swept clean. Potatoes must be passed over a screen in such a manner as to allow as much to come in contact with the screen and to permit the removal of all metallic stems, straw or other stems, immediately prior to loading and placed into new or fresh, clean, laundered, second hand, clean, resuscitated, second hand, clean, or warehouse located on, or within 300 feet of railroad right-of-way.

The term "immediately" shall mean potatoes to run over screen into new or clean container and placed directly into a small number of sacks may be stored and placed on a clean, portion of the space on a railroad right-of-way, or in a period of not to exceed four hours. This privilege shall be obtained with the inspector's charge.

Room requirements have been increased and new rooms, provided for use for car loading, they may be stored in weevil rooms until the car is available for loading. Such rooms may be located in the alfalfa or California when loaded directly from weevil room to car, stacked in the weevil room, provided all doors and other openings are closed; only one person handling refuse of these rooms.

Inspectors will be instructed to refuse to issue weevil certificates, or shipments of potatoes when shipped by shipper or dealers who operate warehouses that are not equipped with regulation weevil rooms. Shipper and operating warehouses must arrange with warehouse owners for the use of such facilities.

When a room must be located within the boundaries of the railroad right-of-way or so situated that the refuse work may be located directly from the weevil room to the car.
