R. W. Meskimen, pilot of the company's westbound plane, reported to the offices here that he sighted the wreckage of Lieut. Caldwell's craft and circling low over the spot, saw the body still in it.

THE REVIVAL OF THE INN
In the old days, when people who had some travel- ing to do climbed into enormous, slow-moving stage coaches and moved along with genteel grandeur, the roadsides were dotted with inns and taverns, which provided food, shelter and a picturesque and enticing charm. Then the railroads came, people got to their journey's end in quicker style, and the inn went the way of all out-moded institutions. But now it seems to be coming back.
Old institutions are seldom restored just as they were, however, and the roadside inn is no exception. It is returning to us in a form that is convenient and often very comfortable, but never in the least picturesque. Its signboard, instead of being a gaily painted board's head or a swagging pirate, is a neatly lettered "Tourists' Rooms"; and the inn itself is either a private home with one or two rooms set aside for wayfarers, or an incredibly cheap, dingy and repellent roadhouse plastered with tin advertisements of chewing gum, cigarettes and soft drinks.
All of this is rather a disappointment. The development of the automobile has put travelers back on the open road once more, in a stage coach; but the overnight accommodations offered now are literally less attractive than those of a century ago.
Probably this is chiefly because the automobile is still such a comparatively new development. Cross-country touring on a really large scale is only a few years old. Right now we are using such makeshift accommodations as could be devised on the spur of the moment. Ten years hence, probably, things will be different.
When the change does come, the American motorist will very likely change his habits. Right now he generally tries to get where he is going as quickly as possible, no matter how much time he has at his disposal. He tears along through beautiful country at 50 miles an hour wearing himself out and tossing lovely landscapes over his shoulder without giving them a glance. Why? Because of some innate restlessness? Possibly; but isn't it more likely that the real reason is the lack of any good in- duements for him to moderate his pace?

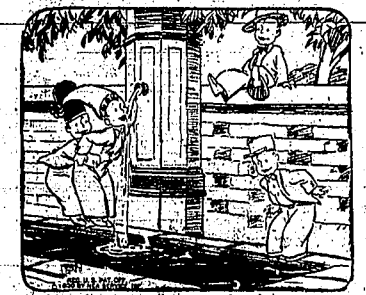

WET PROSPECTS UNIMPRESSIONABLE AT THE POLLS

Anti-Prohibitionists Are Believed To Stand Little Chance of Adding to Power in the Coming Election

NEW YORK, Oct. 16 (UPI)—Despite the agitation of recent months on the subject of prohibition, there is little prospect of the next congress containing more than an "average minority" of wets, unless a considerable number change their stand after election.

A canvass of the situation made by the United Press, covering every congressional district and every senatorial contest in the country, indicates that dry forces will go into the election with 206 congressional districts and 17 senatorial seats already won.

Need But Twelve

To obtain a majority of known and avowed dries in the House they need to elect but 12 more dry congressmen. For the senate, a similar effort would require must win 12 seats in the contest districts.

Ninety-four avowed dry candidates for congress are without opposition in the November election, a large proportion of these being in the southern states. The dry forces can add to these 112 seats which are contested but with all of the candidates pledged to the dry cause. That assured the dries 206 already when the count of ballots begins.

Wets have 12 chances for the House who will be elected without opposition. Louisiana contains three of these and California four. Wisconsin has two and Pennsylvania, South Carolina and Illinois one each. In 24 districts all candidates are wets. Six of these are in Connecticut. Five in Illinois, five in Wisconsin and the others are scattered among New York, New Jersey, Massachusetts, Maryland, Ohio, Washington, Nebraska, Missouri, Michigan and Minnesota. Added together the wets go into the election with 46 seats in the House of Representatives already won.

Victory Already Won

In the Senate, where 24 seats are being filled, the wets have only two districts, where their victory already is won. In New Jersey Dwight W. Morrow, Republican, and Alexander Simpson, Democrat, both are in favor of repeal of the prohibition law. It is the only state where all senatorial candidates are "wets."

Henry P. Jones of Louisiana is the only wet without opposition of any kind for the Senate.

The dry forces on the other hand, have four unopposed candidates for the Senate. They are: Henderson, all Democratic; John Harris of Georgia, Robinson of Arkansas, Harrison of Mississippi, and Byrd of South Carolina. In 12 other states which will elect a total of 12 senators, all candidates are dry. Those states are Virginia, North Carolina, Kentucky, Tennessee, West Virginia, Alabama, South Dakota, Kansas (which elects two senators), Oklahoma, Texas, Colorado and New Mexico.

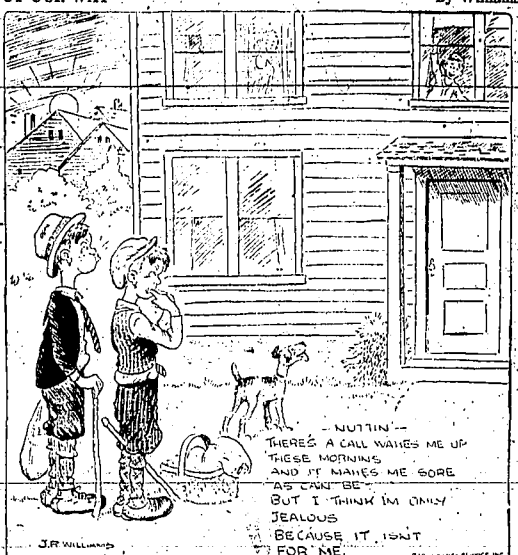
