Leaders Seek Reparations For Slaughter in New Border Incident

WASHINGTON, Nov. 9 (AP)—The Haitian government possesses irrefutable evidence that more than 1,000 of its nationals have been slaughtered on the Dominican Republic side of the border since early October, Haitian Foreign Minister Georges N. Legier told the United Press in an exclusive interview today.

Arriving here for a series of conferences with government officials including President Roosevelt, Legier charged that Dominican reports which minimize the incident and blamed the killing of Haitians on Dominican farmers who said Haitians had "illegally occupied" Dominican land.

EUROPEAN RISE IN PRICE MAKES BUY PROFITABLE

Morgenthau Says America Is Agreeable to Sale to Foreign Countries

BY SANDOR S. KLEIN WASHINGTON, Nov. 9 (Special)—Several European nations were expected today to follow the example of France and ask the United States to sell them some of this country's \$12,800,000,000 store of gold.

France has contracted to purchase \$250 million in gold to maintain the stability of the franc in the face of rising gold prices on the world market. The gold will be taken from the reserve of the assay office in New York and shipped to France Wednesday on the liner Normandie.

The world price of gold on the London market recently rose above \$34.77, the top limit at which it was profitable to ship gold here.

The sale of France marked the first large-scale outward movement of gold since the "sterilization" program, an anti-inflation device, was initiated, the inflow of gold from abroad has totaled \$2,572,000,000 for the period April through June of this year, gold imports averaged \$50,000,000 weekly.

The world price of gold on the London market recently rose above \$34.77, the top limit at which it was profitable to ship gold here.

Morgenthau said France will pay for its gold in dollars.

PROPAGANDA HIT BY EX-PRESIDENT

Hoover Calls for Defenders Of Free Speech to Fight Cultivated 'Untruths'

WATERVILLE, Me., Nov. 9 (Special)—Former President Herbert Hoover called upon defenders of freedom of speech and press today to intensify the fight against "the special breed of cultivated untruth we call propaganda."

Mr. Hoover spoke at Colby college Monday on the 10th anniversary of the death of William English Wallbridge, a Colby graduate who became an abolitionist editor and minister and was killed by a mob which attacked his newspaper plant at Alton, Ill.

"In the past 13 years," Mr. Hoover said, "increasing darkness has descended upon free expression and free criticism in the world. That light has been put out in more than half the so-called civilized earth."
