

### ∧ Hopes for Better Water

Word that the WPA appropriations committee in Washington has approved Twin Falls' application for wa a grant to construct a 5,000,000-gallon water storage in reservoir near the filter plans-comes as welcome news to many-local residents who long since have recognized the need for improvements in our city water by system. system.

With its inadequate storage facilities, our city

With its inadequate storage facilities, our city water system has placed Twin Falls in a precarious position from a fire protection standpoint, and the taste of the water because of these same inadequacies has subjected the city to much criticism.

Although bond issues to improve the water system have been voted down several times, the fact remains that in case of a serious fire, our water supply would be exhausted within approximately an hour, and the

that in case of a serious fire, our water supply would be exhausted within approximately an hour, and the city officials would be faced with the alternative of permitting the fire to run its course, or turning raw, untreated water into the mains and thereby running the risk of causing a serious epidemic.

With sufficient storage capacity, the water department will not only be in position to cope with any major fire, but it will be able to treat the water for a sufficient length of time to remove much of the taste which has been so objectionable.

Some still contend that Twin Falls should have a new source of water supply. Be that as it may, added storage facilities are necessary in any event to give the

storage facilities are necessary in any event to give the city an efficient water system.

And the majority of the people in Twin Falls will hope that work may soon be started on a new reservoir without further delay or slip-up.






