

Our Record Better Than Most

A lot of people, discussing the conquests of the Ger mans, Italians and Japanese, dismiss the whole mat-ter by saying, "Oh, well, it's no worse than we did our-

ter by saying, "Oh, well, it's no worse than we did our selves when we were expanding."

That's a very easy answer, but unfortunately, like many easy answers, it isn't so.

The aggressions and conquests of today are worse than our own. People who speak so about American expansion just haven't followed Al Smith's suggestion that we "look at the record."

The American record in territorial expansion is no lily-pure sheet, and it falls far short of ideal standards. But comparatively it is way above the average. The record of ruthless warfare and repeatedly broken faith in conflict with the aboviginal Indians is not pretty. We came, we saw their lands, we took them. We killed many.

Yet it might have been worse. Ever since, we have been shelling out millions to keep them in a style to which we would like to have them become accustomed, and there are probably more of them today than hore were when Columbus landed.

Our first big expansion was Louisiana in 1803.
This wast western area, which raised by 140 per cent the American land area, was bought for 80,000,000 francs. A cheap price, certainly, yet one which Napoleon was glad to get, and which was important money to a struggling and poor young republic.
When we took Florida from Spain, there was coercion certainly, yet we assumed claims up to \$5,000,000 against that government. Conscience money? Perhaps, but it at least shows that we had a conscience.

Many still regard the Mexican war as naked aggression. Perhaps it was. After the Boxer uprising in China, the U. S. got \$24,000,000 of the indemnity, and, deciding in 1907 that it was \$13,000,000 too much, handed back the amount to China.

We're not arguing that the American record in imperialistic expansion is 99 44 100ths per cent pure. It isn't.

We're only contending that, when stacked up against the record of some other countries, our record of 50 and 100 years ago, remembering that much of the land concerned was practically uninhabited, presents some things of which we can be proud proud.

Manchuria must not be allowed to get away with their continual implications that, "Oh, well, you were just us had 100 yours no." just as bad 100 years ago,"

The United States is rapidly filling with people from other countries who must, for various reasons, live abroad. Practically all of them are still interested in politics back in the hame country, and are working to bring about political change there.

Within limits this is all right. But the United States reserves the right to expect, first, complete loyalty from these people and, second, limits to their interguing against the home governments.

If this is true, it should be stopped as an abuse of the right of asylum. No military or foreible conspiracy against any government with which the United States is at peace should be tolerated.

The Czechs have the right idea, propounded by Benes and seconded by a Pittsburgh meeting—that they can best serve democracy in their home lands by pitching in to help make democracy a success here, thus showing the world that the democratic way is, after all, the best.
