# World Listens As Leader Hits "Encirclement'

BERLIN, April 28 U.P.—Adolf Hitler today scornfully rejected President Roosevelt's peace message, demanded return of Danzig to the reich, and denounced treaties with Poland and Great Britain.

"I must decline to give any explanation to anybody except to the nation, for whose security and safety I am responsible," he said of Mr. Roosevelt's request for a nonaggression pledge to 31 nations. He called the President's appeal a breach of good manners.

In one of the most cloquent speeches of his career, and possibly in its implications the most portentous, Hitler, addressing his Nazi reichstag, swept over the problems of the world and taunted Mr. Roosevelt with sharp-tongued comment on unemployment and America's role in world affairs.

In disclosing his demand for the return of Danzig, Hetler compared Poland's present position to that of Czechoslovakia before he dismembered the post-war republic.

He denounced the German-Polats hriendship treaty on the ground that Poland had violated in by entering an "encirclement" pact with Britain. Charles F. Kettering, research chief for General Motors, is an inventor and, technician. From that point of view, no one has better outlined our position than Kettering did in these recent words:

than Kettering did in these recent words:

"Today we have an unusual condition because there is an excess of materials, an excess of money, and an excess of manpower—All that means to me is that we haven't enough projects to work on. It means we are technicologically behind, not technicologically abead.

"Not enough work to do, and there's so much yet to be done! ... Never was there such an opportunity to do things; but we can't go on doing only the same things we are doing now. We have got to open up a new field, and there are thousands of new fields waiting.

'It's up to us to find our way into them. If we can only get some of these new projects under way we won't have enough materials or money or men to do the job. And we can start apywhere. There's no end to the opportunities."

There stands man — a wealth of material at his elbow, a pile of money ready at his hand, 10,000,000 men Feady and waiting to go to work. And because he hasn't the wit to devise uses that will bring these three together, the money, and the materials, and even the men rust in disuse.

The answer probably will come, but not in one blind-

The answer propably will come, but not in one binding flash that will start things humbing day after tomorrow. It will come little by little as one idea after another timidly tiptoes into the water, finds it not so cold after all, and then boldly begins to swim. Certainly Kettering is right when he says that we can't go on doing only the same things we are doing now. It is the new things that are needed.

In the horse-and-buggy days it was an unusual family that kept a horse-and-buggy. But when the auto age came, the auto became a virtual necessity in

auto age came, the auto became a virtual necessity in a far higher percentage of families than ever dared aspire to have their own stable.

Why do we say that, because in the past land and a home were only for the few, it need be so? There is land for all, and building material for all. More things for more people is the only way out. But only the engineers and technologists realize it fully.

The rest of us yearn for the "good old days," realizing that they weren't half good enough, and that what is needed is not a return to the good old days, but a determined advance to a better day.

## A Dubious Future

Unpleasant reading to coal miners who consider

Gupleasant reading to awal miners who consider striking because of failure to reach a new working agreement, will be the announcement that Russia is experimenting with plans to convert underground coal into its products while still in the ground, and without mining it at all.

The system simply involves setting fire to the underground mine, and controlling the intake of oxygen and the exhaust of coal gases in such a way as to utilize the latter. The process already is in practical use in the Soxiet Union, and if it is every generally adopted, it means that a "coal mine" would employ no underground "miners," but simply after technical workers at the surface.

The problem of coal miners, faced by decreasing coal consumption, is tough enough. Any such plan suddenly applied in the United States would mean a wholesale displacement of still more miners.

Would it so cheapen gas and coal products as to lead to employment of all the displaced men? Eventually, perhaps, but in the meantime the displacement problem and its lag would persist.




