RESIGNATION OF JUSTICE HINTED

Van Devanter Farm Purchase Indicates Conservative May Step Out

WASHINGTON, Jan. 17 (AP)—Reports that Justice Willis Van Devanter may resign soon from the supreme court were revived today by the purchase of a farm

The farm, described as of "300 or 400 acres," is beyond easy commuting distance from Washington. Elliott City is one of the picturesque old villages on a "back route" to Baltimore.

Oldest in Service
Van Devanter, at 77, is the oldest member of the court in years of service and the second oldest in age. He is three years the junior of Justice Louis D. Brandeis, dean of the liberal faction, who will be 80 this year.

Van Devanter, who has been in poor health, there was little to substantiate the report, and the court always declines to discuss such reports and the justice himself could not be reached for comment. First word of a resignation usually comes from the White House, where it is authorized by the dean of conservatives.

Observers believed that if Van Devanter, dean of conservatives on the bench, should resign and be replaced by a liberal that congressional legislation for restriction of the court powers might be dropped. The court is almost evenly divided between conservatives and liberals. Chief Justice Charles Evans Hughes swinging the balance, have been frequent. Van Devanter has voted against most New Deal measures.

There has not been a supreme court resignation since the late Justice Oliver Wendell Holmes said he would retire in 1932.

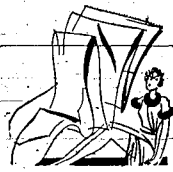

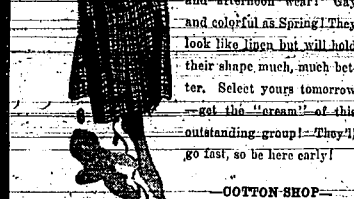
