# Records Topple as College Swimmers Enter Closing Events

## MEDICARETAINS TWO OF CROWNS

Will Attempt to Win Third Straight for His Third Consecutive Year

NEW HAVEN, Conn., March 28 (U.P.)—With three intercollegiate records already smashed, American record holder, Jack Macdonald, will attempt today to crack additional marks in the windup of the 18th annual national meet of the collegiate athletic association in Payson, Wis. Preliminary events were scheduled in five events in the afternoon, the first at 4:30 p.m.

One of the day's highlights will be Jack Macdonald's attempt to win his third straight title for the third consecutive year. The black-haired Washington swimmer successfully defended two of his titles yesterday in the 1,500-meter and 200-yard free style, setting a new intercollegiate record of 2 minutes 9.6 seconds in the latter.

Alma at Records  
Macdonald, who swam the fastest 200 yards in competition in his career in staving off the closing rush of John Macdonald, Yale's brilliant sophomore, planned today to set off the world as well as the intercollegiate record in the 400-yard free style.

He holds the world record of 4:08.4 made in Honolulu in 1934 and the intercollegiate mark of 4:42.0 made at Cambridge, Mass., last year.

The other events on today's program were the 100-yard free style, in which Charlie Hutter, Harvard, eastern champion; Jimmy Gildea, Boston, and Jimmy Ray, Walters, Iowa, 50-yard free style champion, and John Macdonald, Yale, were the leading contenders; the 200-yard breast stroke, in which Jack Macdonald, Michigan, will be looking to set a record; the 400-yard relay, in which Harvard, Iowa and Illinois are the favored teams; and the 100-meter high board, in which Frank Fehsenfeld, Michigan, and Jim Peterson, Ohio State, will continue their Big Ten rivalry.

Relay Record

In addition to Macdonald's new mark in the 200-yard free style, Michigan university's team set a new intercollegiate record in winning the 800-yard relay in 10 minutes 21.0 seconds, and Danny Rehr, Northwestern, hung up a new mark of 1:00.4 in the 100-yard high board.

Michigan was favored to take the unofficial team title for the second straight year. It had scored 10 points in yesterday's competition and were favored to win another title today in the 200-yard relay, in which they placed several men in the three-meter diving.

## COAST LEAGUERS START '36 PLAY

Closer Competition and Change in Methods Offer Bright Season Prospects

SAN FRANCISCO, March 28 (U.P.)—Spectators to provide cheer or competition and greater fan interest, the 1936 season of the Pacific coast baseball league opens today on four California ballfields.

Northwest plays at Sacramento, Seattle at Oakland, San Diego at Los Angeles, and the Mission Reds at San Francisco. The league directors have done a good job in setting up the stage effects for the campaign. They lengthened the interclub series to a full week of games, as it was in the years before 1935, and they cut the length of the season, keeping it from expanding all over September and into competition with football crowds.

Playoff at End

Their crowning achievement of a winter of engineering and optimism has been the inauguration of the "O'Shaughnessy plan" to the league, the general manager. When Sept. 13 rolls around and the teams fold up the regular schedule with doubleheaders, the four teams presenting the highest standing will plunge into special series from which will emerge the two teams which will play in the series will share a special fund, with the winners, of getting the largest slice of pie.

The arrangement offers an incentive to the teams to play hard in the sixth and seventh place by Aug. 13, for if they can climb above the 10th place, they will be carrying off premier honors.
