AMERICA WAITS

Given 48 more hours to live, Bruno Richard Hauptmann, condemned slayer of the Lindbergh baby, has provided the world with another sensational chapter in the chain of events which has marked the historic case now more than four years old.

If real justice is being served there can be no warranted criticism of the postponement. But there is indication that the condemned prisoner's execution is inevitable and that further delays only weaken respect for law and for the verdict which called for the death sentence.

No one countenances the taking of an innocent man's life, just because the crime with which he is charged is as sensational as that for which Hauptmann was legally convicted. If there ever was any question of his guilt his jury men peers but ample opportunity to discover it and thus absolve the Teutonic carpenter.

But the established course of justice in the United States has branded Hauptmann as the perpetrator of the crime; in the minds of the jury all the evidence fastened the offense upon the defendant and his sentence to death followed in logical course.

There have been delays without end—even now there is raised a doubt as to if and when the condemned slayer will pay the adjured penalty.

And meanwhile Hauptmann continues to be the benefactor of the recurring reprieves resulting from the actions either of faltering officials or of very brave and astute ones. Which they are, remains to be seen.

But it is evident there cannot continue to be amazement. Sooner or later, for the benefit both of Hauptmann and the public morale, there should be a display of authority which will put an end to indecision, and establish the fact that justice holds sway.

WARNING FROM ALASKA

The exigencies of unemployment in the United States, together with the lure of gold and adventure in the Far North, once more is turning a tide of immigration toward Alaska.

So heavy, in fact, has become the flood of inquiries regarding opportunities in the territory that the government there has issued warnings against premature settlement.

There is opportunity in Alaska, perhaps for several thousand people, territorial officials point out, but adequate financing and steady employment ought to be assured before anyone tries the hard life of the north.

Gold? Mineralogists of the Bureau of Mines report there is probably as much gold left in Alaska as was ever taken out. But the catch is that it is not mined so easily. It takes money to acquire gold in Alaska.

As for the other industries, employment is scarce and agriculture is practically out of the question until markets are developed.

II. DUCB CHECKS PROFITS

Whatever one may conclude about Mussolini's corporate state, there is no doubt that II Duce offers an interesting challenge to the war makers.

By his latest decree all large private industries are placed under state control and management, to the end that there will be no profiteering in Italy in the event of another war.

And such war is inevitable, II Duce believes. Hence, he warns, it is vital that the state clamp down now on any opportunity for huge private gain incident to a conflict.

Obviously, of course, Mussolini's last extension of his dictatorship is not surprising. He has aimed at no less than nationalization of Italian industry for a long time. But it is significant that, having recognized the place of profiteering in war making, he has moved to abolish it.

UNDIVIDED FLOOD CONTROL

It is certainly no pleasant commentary on Congress to accuse it of playing politics with projects that affect human life and welfare. For instance, any effort to make political capital out of the recent flood disasters is deeply disgusting to the honest American.

It is, therefore, decidedly encouraging to note that the present Congress is simplifying a \$500,000,000 flood control bill by trying to eliminate the traditional "pork barrel."

Chairman Copeland of the Senate Commerce Committee points out that this bill will establish for the first time the definite rule that henceforth all flood control projects must first be approved by army engineers.

"And by doing that," he explains, "we will do away with all pork barrel projects."



Nazis Say Actions, Not Looks, Determine Whether Man is Nordic or Not

BERLIN (UPI)—A German may be tall, blond and have a long skull and not be a Nordic; and again he may be short, dark, with brown eyes and curly hair, yet be a Nordic, for in this country looks—but actions—decide the race.

This is the latest criterion pro-

pagated by Nazi racial experts.

It at once reveals the ramifications of the racial problem for the Nazi party among whom most believe that a person of half-Nordic blood will find it hard to detect one who, according to the Nazis, is not.

Adolf Hitler is said

Paul Goebbels, minister of propa-

ganda, is even more so. Hermann Göring, air force commander,

Hitler's "Führer" type, Dr. Hjalmer, director of the Reichsbank, is perhaps the only Nordic in the whole cabinet.

Procedure used as Guide

So far, the new criterion has been applied only to members of the Nazi party, according to Dr. Eugen Stäble, ministerial councillor in the Whirttemberg ministry of the interior. His actions, moreover, have been determined by the Nazi district headquarters.
