

The Unfed States may have decided, during the Leagu Nations campaign in 1920; to pursue a coing isolation in its relations with the outside world, but you can't say that it isn't getting plenty of chances to change its mind.

The most recent one, of course, is the proposition ad vanced by the heads of three Latin American nations for a league of New World states to keep the peace, settle argu-ments, and turn the "good neighbor" policy into something that you can get cashed at the bank.






