This year, as in 1924, midwestern liberals advanced to
the field with banners flying. But the solid Old Guard

It found a few stubborn rearguard actions, to be sure There were moments when it managed to give the conven tion, superficially, an echo of bygone days. In the end, however, it left the field in disorder. The Old Guard lived by the name of Abraham Lincoln

and the philosophy of William McKinley. These may be excellent things to live by, but they do not have too much di rect application to modern life.

You cannot meet the infinitely complex problems of a modern industrial civilization by reminding people that Mr. Lincoln was a great man and that McKinley believed in Fr. Lincoln was a great in the full dinner pail,

What happened in Cleveland was nothing less than a whilt of power from this Old Guard group to a set of men who understand that they are living in a changed world and propose to do something about it.

Governor Landon is a new kind of candidate for the G. O. P. He is not the sort of man the party could conceivably bave nominated in 1924 or 1928 or 1932.

He belongs to 1936, and the fact that he was the all but namimous choice of the delegates before the balloting even started is an interesting fact.

For it shows that the party may not die of hardening of the arteries; that It has in it the ability to change in the continuous face of changing conditions.

The Old Guard has left the field. It may return some day; but, before it does, Mr. Landon will teach it some thing.
