GIVES SUMMARY OF IDAHO'S CROP SITUATION NOW

Weather Conditions Reported by Department of Agriculture Shows Good Conditions Throughout State

The weekly summary of weather and crop conditions in Idaho for the week ending Tuesday, May 8, as given out by the U. S. Department of Agriculture is as follows:

Crop Summary

North Idaho: At the beginning of the week there were rains in the lower sections and a mixture of rain and snow in the higher sections. After this the weather was for the most part clear.

South Idaho: Heavy frosts and freezing temperatures occurred quite generally in this district early in the week, but due to the backward state of vegetation, no extensive damage occurred.

The week was not greatly marked. During the latter half of the week, very warm weather obtained, the warmest of the season occurred. This, with abundant sunshine, was very beneficial to crops, where soil moisture was adequate.

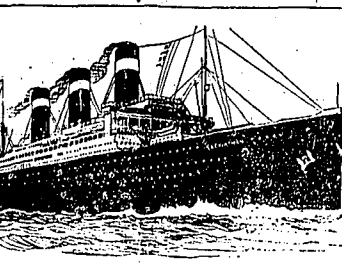
Notes from the Field
