COMPARATIVE PARTY STRENGTH

It is not everyone who stops to realize the comparative strength of the two leading political parties in the United States. Neither one has a strangle-hold on this or any other election, and as far as edginess is concerned control of that body is constantly being subjected to change.

Take the situation in the United States senate, composed of 96 senators. Half of this number is 48—and the Democrats have 47, one less than half.

Of the forty-eight state governors in the United States, 24 are Democratic, only three less than half.

The situation in the national house of representatives is similar of the 435 members, nearly 200 are Democratic. Students of public should keep these facts before them when considering the national political situation, bearing in mind the relative strength of the two parties. Furthermore, since the inauguration of George Washington as president, 140 years ago, the country has been governed just half this time by Democratic and the other half by Republican presidents.

VIGOROUS RAM AID TO FLOCK

The statement has often been made that success in livestock production rests fifty per cent with breeding and fifty per cent with the owners' ability to feed properly. The old saying that, "the ram is half the flock" is true. In the production of lambs for commercial use it is necessary to have a lamb of quality, early maturing, compact and fleshy, a superior article. Scrub rams will not produce lambs of this kind.

Remember that 50 per cent of the inherited qualities of the lamb comes from the ram. In selecting and buying a ram, you should look at it on a service basis, not the first cost. Suppose, for instance, in the production of lambs that the ram may add one dollar each to the value of his progeny as compared with a cheaper ram. This is a very conservative estimate and it is possible that it might even be much more. It is very easy to figure that in the course of his usefulness in breeding 200 to 225 ewes and the production of the same number of lambs or even more, the pure-bred ram will pay. The good ram may cost \$50.00 as compared with the \$15.00 scrub, but the good ram will pay for itself with the first crop of lambs.

Experiments show that cross-bred ewes bred to better buck have fewer dry ewes, more twins and the lambs are heavier and fattened younger. For the sheepman this means more money.

POLITICAL RAMBLINGS

We are now entering the home stretch for the primary election but not much printer's ink is being spread so far. Hall and Larson have got their feet wet in that regard, these twin oping each other—and Judge Duval for the Republican nomination for county attorney. Of the six Republican candidates for sheriff, only Gilbert and Redmon have so far published their pictures in the papers.

Have you noticed the absence of women candidates? Only one, we recall—Miss Pond, candidate for county superintendent—with no opposition in either her own or opposing party.

Two old timers are opposing each other in the Republican senate race: M. J. Sweeney, Twin Falls and F. C. Graves, Ellier.

But the interesting battle will be waged in the sheriff contest. Nine candidates, all told, seek the two nominations—three on the Democratic ticket; Prater, Kendall and Sheriff Finch, and six under the G. O. P. standard—Toney, Hice, Busted, Redmon, Kennison—and Gilbert. Most anyone is liable to win.

Neither Ware nor Barnes, present county commissioners will have any opposition in the primaries, but Chairman Moore of the west-end has two adversaries in H. C. Rehke of Clover and W. A. Thompson of Buhl. It will be a close race between two of them.

In district No. 2, Windle and Denny will fight it out for the Democratic commissioner nomination, and in No. 3 Breckon and Moses seek similar honors from the Republicans. Breckon has served as commissioner in the past.

Coroner Grossman is being opposed for the nomination by F. E. Drake, both on the Republican ticket.

The only other contest on the county tickets is that between Assessor Stewart and H. M. Holler. These same two were pitted against each other two years ago, but despite machine support, Stewart won both the nomination and election.

Better be sure you are registered, for a deputy primary campaign may yet develop some excitement.

GRASSE AND TROUT

The state game department, at the suggestion of sportmen associations, has been authorized to open up trout season on agriculture in Southern Idaho this year. This is a move for the protection of the birds, which it is believed would be hardly depleted by an open season this year. Last year the open season was restricted to the same areas. Hence this alternative to work for a road from American Falls to Mindoko could connect up with the North Side highway—and this was done.

Burley and Twin Falls, now making considerable noise in opposition to the present plan, will have only themselves to blame if they are hurt by the new highway, because there were only indications of which point to its construction.

Rupert, however, is just as much interested in not having the highway continued over the desert from Mindoko to Shoshone as are our neighbors, and there is no indication of any intention of building this road. Some day, no doubt, this piece of road will be built, but the building of the road from American Falls to Mindoko to connect with the North Side highway, with a subsequent oiled road from Jerome to Shoshone and one from Gooding to Shoshone to connect with a similar road from Shoshone to Hazelton will postpone the construction of the road down the track at least ten years.

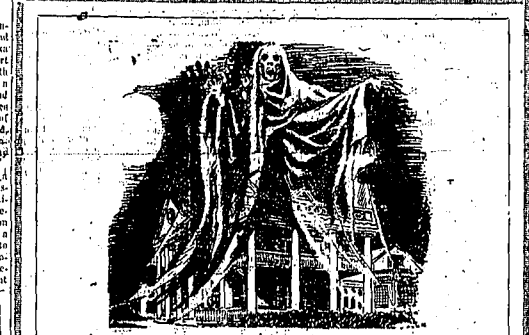
