#### THERE IS A DIFFERENCE

The Idaho Free Press of Nampa takes exception to an editorial of The Citizen published a month ago which said that Mayor Ross and the Democratic party take the same position that the Progressive party did on state affairs and that if the Progressive party would unite in voting this and that if the Progressive party would unite in voling this year with the Democrats they could elect the attate ticket. The Free Press said "In the state of Idaho, there has been no difference between the two old parties except as one has been in office and the other out."

This does not agree with what W. Scott Hall, who was running for governor on the Progressive ticket in 1926 and was supported by the Free Press, told the people of Twin Falls county when he was on the stump here.

He said that the administration of Governor D. W. Baris was much worse and much more expensive than the

Davis was much worse and much more expensive than the Davis was much worse and much more expensive than the administration of Governor M. Alexander, and that the administration of C. C. Moore was less efficient and more expensive than the administration of D. W. Davis. He said if H. C. Baldridge should win, his administration would be more expensive that either.

Files of the papers show that he traced the tax devy from the time of Alexandèr when it was the lowest at any time in 20 years up to 1925. The rates were Alexander: 1915, \$1.92; 1916, \$1.51; 1917, \$2.15; 1918, \$2.70; Davis, 1919, \$7.83; 1920, \$6.13; 1921, \$5.57; 1922, \$5.40; 1923, \$1.77; 1924, \$4.76; 1926, \$3.60; 1926, \$4.60.

The rise in the levy during the last two years of the Alexander administration was due to war prices. In his last year Alexander and his board cut valuations \$27,000,000 and Davis and his board raised them back \$20,000,000 to the raise in taxes under Davis was greater than it seemed to be even considering the big raise in the

But Mr. Hall said that did not measure the whole diftevence.
