STATE SENATE PASSES THREE BILLS FOR DAY

Friday's Session in the Upper House Dull; Highway and Irrigation Provisions Meet With Approval.

BOISE, Feb. 6.—Today was a dull day in the upper house, no bills being introduced, only three being passed. The Hugen act providing that land included in public highways shall be subject to taxation provided favorable to the state and the hands of the state.

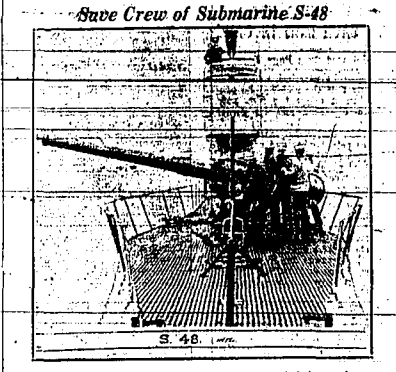

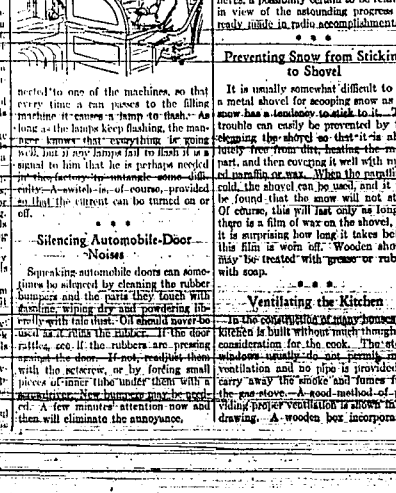
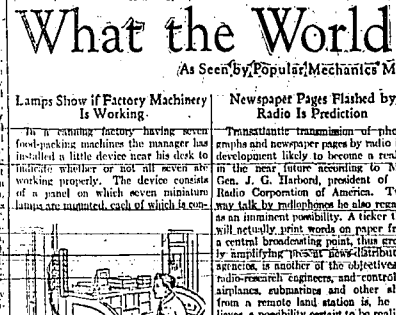
