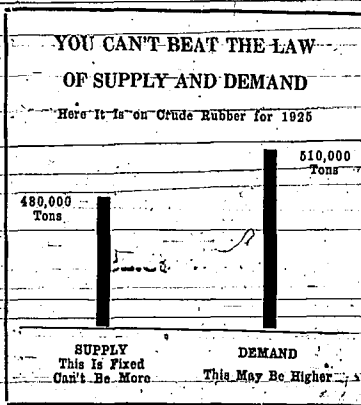

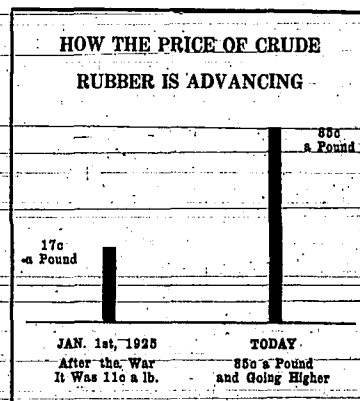

This restriction may be relief to the rubber growers but it is grief to American tire manufacturers and tire buyers, for which the consumption of rubber is greatly increasing (due in a measure to the balloon type of tire) the production of crude rubber, by this law, is greatly decreased.

For example, the world production of crude rubber for 1925 will be 480,000 tons, and the estimated consumption of rubber this year will be at least 510,000 tons. Figure this out for yourself and you will agree we are right when
