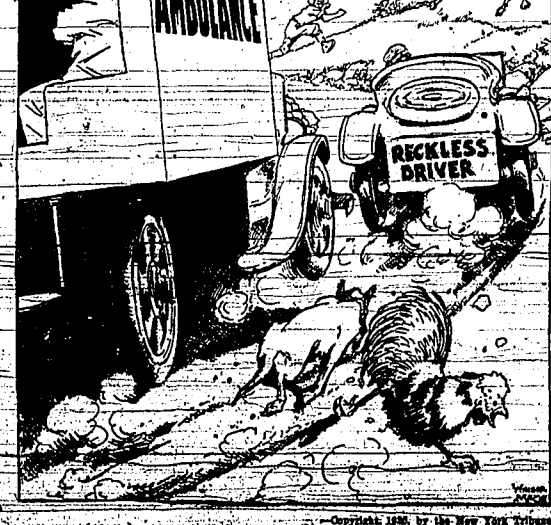

## Many Trout Caught Cedar Creek Home

Results attained at the Cedar creek hatchery during the season just closed have produced a total of 1,500,000 eggs which have been delivered with a minimum loss to state hatcheries from May since the hatchery for hatching successful results, according to John Salisbury, deputy state game warden for this district.

Results attained at the Cedar creek hatchery are such that the state fish and game department has advised Mr. Salisbury that the hatchery is the points that it will pay to operate permanently.
