MAN ON TRIAL AT SCENE OF FATAL CRASH Henry Harris, Accused of Manslaughter, Goes With Attorneys and Jury to View Premises Where Cars Collided.

During a half-hour intermission in the trial in district court here Tuesday in the case of Henry Harris charged with manslaughter, Harris, with defense and state's attorneys and members of the jury who are to determine the guilt or innocence of the charge, visited the premises where the Hudson tourist driven by Harris crashed into the rear end of a Ford log in which five young men were traveling in the highway.

Defense attorneys stated that the defendant was not negligent in the crash. The state's attorney, Howard Gillette, one of the young men in the wrecked car, advised the jury that the defendant was negligent. The prosecution in the case of the fatal mishap was made after the state rested its case at noon.
