ANNUAL CONFAB OF FEDERATION COMES TO END

Forty-Fifth Convention of Labor Closes at Atlantic City. Much Work Completed During Sessions.

ATLANTIC CITY, Oct. 16. (AP)—The forty-fifth annual convention of the International Federation of Laborers and Craft Unions, which opened here today and was characterized by President William Green, in a far-reaching address to the delegates, as "the most constructive convention the federation ever held—some that will make history." He commended the work accomplished at the session lasting eleven business days, to that of a course of university training.

Resolutions were adopted during the final session. Two resolutions on the relations of labor and the proposed International Banking company, and the other of the Bill Tamm plan, were adopted. Resolutions adopted charged the Wood company with curtailing union labor and keeping up the price of bread, even during the war. It was charged that the company and other companies in the proposed merger would control the production and distribution of the country.

The Hull system, which has been adopted at previous sessions of the federation, was charged with having a monopolistic grip on a vital public necessity, detrimental to the welfare of the country.

There was a lengthy discussion in China, which the federation finally decided to urge the withdrawal of territorial privileges from all nations.

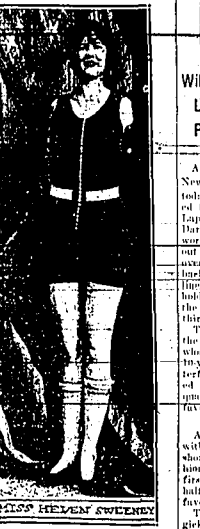

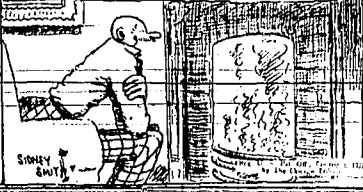
