

UNIVERSITY Head Gives Views On Trip Overseas

UNIVERSITY OF IDAHO: Moscow, Jan. 19.—Wesleyan seminary was here this week for Dr. A. G. Upman, president of the University, who returned last evening. He said students and faculty declared they "breath and gusto" morning and the site of Moscow "stretched us all along the land."

Upman said he was "impressed by the University's work."

ENGINEERS WILL CONTINUE WORK ON BUHL SURVEY

Twin Falls Chamber of Commerce Votes to See Western Extension Project to Conclusion.

Twin Falls Chamber of Commerce directors, at a special meeting held yesterday in the Hotel Fernie, heard the preliminary reports of D. F. Clark and John McDonald, civil engineers who have been given a wide view to locating a feasible route for extension of the Oregon Short Line west from Buhl to connect with the main west of Kinn Hill, and authorized additional appropriation to insure completion of the survey.

The engineers engaged in this work, in the employ of the Shoshone Lines some time ago, are now back in the valley for the extension of the line west from Buhl across Salmon river canyon. They are now endeavoring to locate a route which will lead from Buhl in a northwesterly direction to Twin Falls or Snake river.

The survey has been under way for about two weeks. It is being financed by Buhl business men and Twin Falls Chamber of Commerce.

Park Project to Form

A park project committee, appointed by the directors to submit a detailed report setting forth their information concerning the proposed state park, together with the statement as to the amount of money required for its construction and estimate of revenue which reasonably may be expected from its operation.

Report of a special committee having charge of a plan for building a bridge over the Snake River, which would add to the effect that within two weeks definite conclusions probably would be reached.

American Falls District to Sell Additional Bonds

American Falls reservoir directors at a calligraphic meeting last night, authorized sale of \$100,000 worth of district bonds for purchase of approximately 11,000 acre-feet of storage water in American Falls reservoir to be used in irrigation of lands recently opened to the district.

The bonds, which are to be sold on April 1, next, are a part of the unappropriated \$1,000,000 bond issue of \$200,000 voted in 1923, last, dedicated to the district, for the benefit of which this expenditure is

to be made proportionately in all parts of the district.

Water storage bonds issued in the Twin Falls county, Custer, irrigation project of 3,000 acres and an approximate \$120,000,000 worth of irrigation equipment, and approximately 90,000 acres of the American Springsfield project, will be available for distribution through the district, supplemental water supplies for the Woodville Canal company in the amount of 300 acre feet, and for the Main Canal company in the amount of 500 acre feet.
